


Minor river and surface water flooding impacts are possible at times across parts of England and Wales from Tuesday to Friday. Coastal flooding is possible but not expected for parts of the south of England coast on Friday. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.





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## Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible from Tuesday to Friday (see Specific Areas of Concern Maps), and are possible but not expected more widely across parts of England and Wales, perhaps continuing into Saturday for parts of the North East Coast and Yorkshire and the Humber. This is due to several periods of heavy and persistent rainfall.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday (see Specific Areas of Concern Maps), and are possible but not expected more widely across parts of England and Wales. This is due to several periods of heavy and persistent rainfall.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



## Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of the south coast of England on Friday due to the potential for southerly gales, surge and large waves.

# Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



## Summary of potential impacts

### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
