



#### Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW for the next five days.

Localised minor river flooding impacts are expected today (Saturday) and tomorrow in parts of the Midlands and are probable in places until Wednesday. Localised minor river flooding impacts are possible more widely across England today and tomorrow as rivers respond to new and recent rainfall. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps for details.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected in the South of England and Wales on Saturday and Sunday, and across Wales and the South West and North of England on Tuesday and Wednesday.



#### Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW from Saturday until Tuesday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable along parts of the Wales coasts from Saturday until Tuesday, and possible for parts of the coast of England until Tuesday, due to high spring tides. See Areas of Concern Map.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible but not expected for other parts of the coasts of England and Wales today through to Tuesday.



## Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Saturday) and tomorrow (Sunday).

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable today and tomorrow in parts of Yorkshire, the East Midlands, the East and South West of England. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Minor surface water impacts are also possible but not expected today and tomorrow in parts of South England and South Wales due to showers and for Wales, the South West and North of England on Tuesday and Wednesday due to widespread heavy rain.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



## Summary of potential impacts

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
