





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Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Tuesday 12 March 2024




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Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Wednesday 13 March 2024





Assessment of flood risk



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are probable across parts of the South of England during the next five days. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible along parts of the coast of Wales, North West and South West England and along the lower reaches of the Rivers Wye, Severn, Towy and Usk on Tuesday and Wednesday. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps 2 and 3.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible but not expected more widely along the coast of England on Monday until Wednesday.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of England and Wales on Wednesday and Thursday due to heavy and persistent rain.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of England and Wales on Wednesday and Thursday due to heavy and persistent rain.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
