


Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England and Wales later today (Wednesday) and into Thursday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

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

A chance of heavy showers and thunderstorms





Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Wednesday) and Thursday.

A band of rain, heavy showers and thunderstorms brings the chance of surface water flooding from later today and into tomorrow. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible in parts of the East and South East of England on Friday and possible but not expected more widely in parts of England and Wales. This is due to the possibility of further heavy showers and thunderstorms.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England and Wales today (Wednesday) and into Thursday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

The level of the ongoing disruption caused by groundwater flooding in the South of England is not forecast to get worse, the flooding is being managed and awareness is high. Consequently the groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
