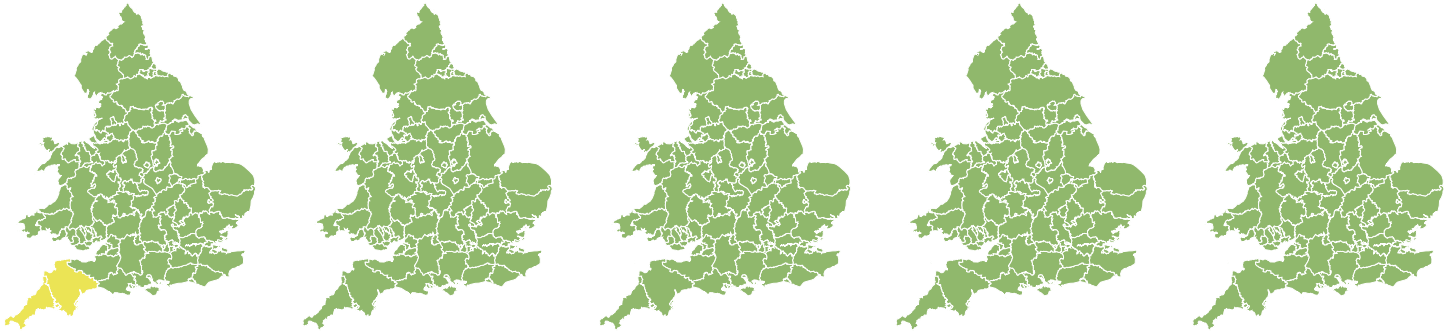


# Flood Guidance Statement

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of South West England today (Friday). The overall flood risk is LOW.

 Likelihood **VERY LOW**

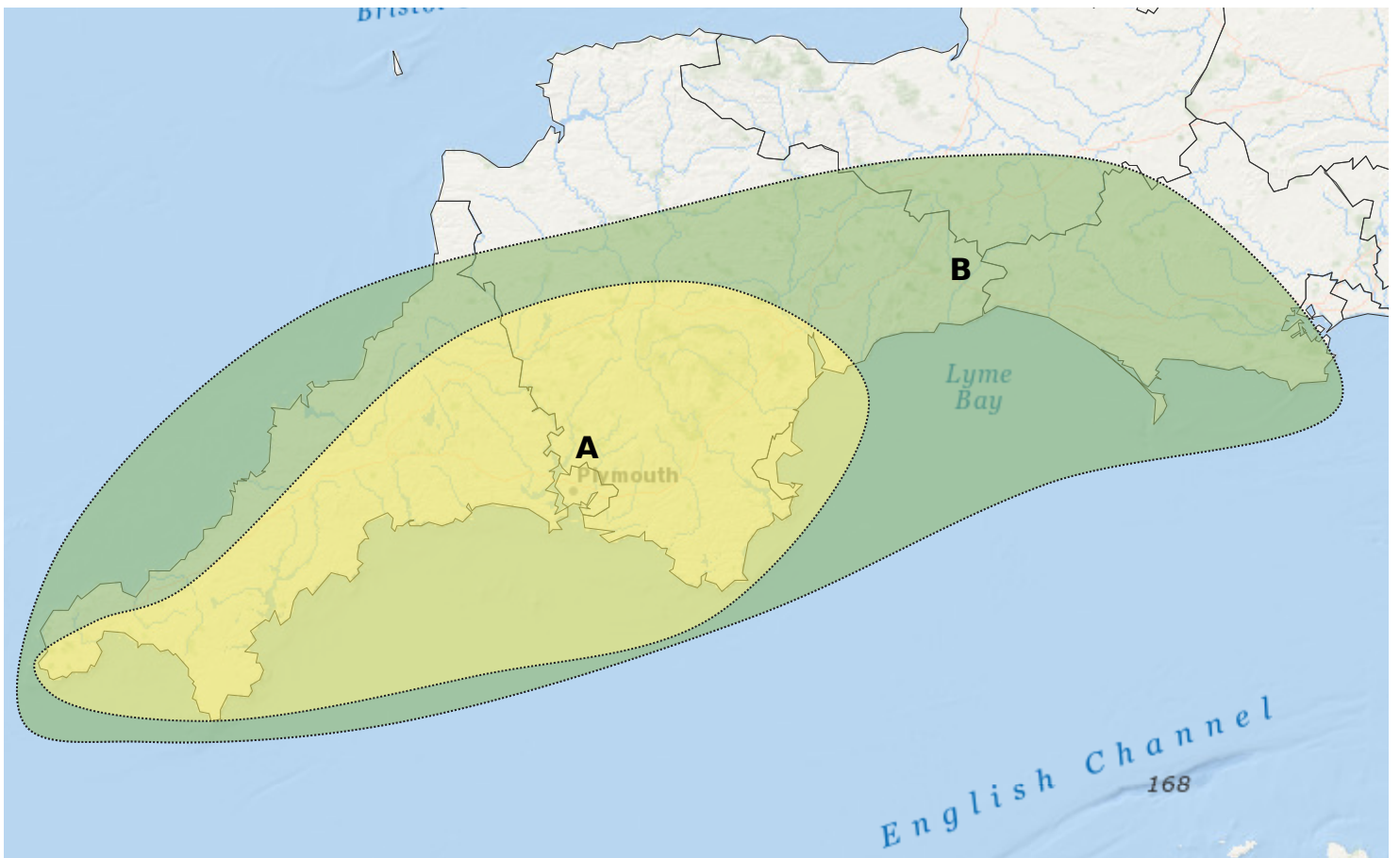
Source Surface

Slow moving, heavy showers possible



## Assessment of flood risk



### Surface water

---

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Friday).

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Devon and Cornwall, with minor impacts possible more widely across South West England today. This is due to slow moving, heavy showers. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor surface water flood impacts are also possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales on Saturday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



### Rivers

---

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



### Coastal/Tidal

---

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



### Groundwater

---

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

## Summary of potential impacts

### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
