
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
## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Thursday 22 August 2024






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## Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Friday 23 August 2024



Source Coastal/Tidal Likely duration 1 Day

High tides along with strong winds may lead to localised spray and over-topping.



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### Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible on Thursday in Cumbria due to short-duration heavy rainfall in the morning.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible on Thursday in Cumbria due to short-duration heavy rainfall in the morning.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of England on Saturday due to heavy rainfall.



# Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible on Thursday along parts of the North-West of England coasts. Minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible on Friday along the Yorkshire and the Humber coasts.

Isolated minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected along other stretches of the England and Wales coasts from Wednesday to Friday.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.


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## Summary of potential impacts

### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
