


Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected on Saturday and possible on Sunday, while minor surface water flooding impacts are possible on Friday. The overall flood risk for England and Wales is LOW on Saturday and Sunday.

Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 - Saturday 21 September 2024





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

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Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW on Saturday and Sunday.

Heavy showers and thunderstorms today (Friday) through Sunday may bring localised surface water flooding impacts across parts of England and Wales. See Specific Area of Concern Maps.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected on Sunday due to heavy and potentially persistent rain falling onto catchments on consecutive days. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

🖸 Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minimal coastal impacts are expected along some coasts from today (Friday) to Sunday due to high peak water levels. Impacts may include coastal overtopping on low-lying roads and coastal promenades.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
