



Minor ongoing river flooding impacts are expected in parts of England on Friday and Saturday. Minor inland flooding impacts are also possible across parts of Wales and England on Sunday and Monday. The overall flood risk is LOW.










Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Sunday 29 and Monday 30 September 2024

Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW today (Friday) and Saturday.

Following recent rainfall, minor ongoing river flooding impacts are expected in parts of England today and Saturday. Minor river flooding impacts are also possible across parts of Wales, and possible but not expected more widely in parts of England on Sunday and Monday. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of Wales on Sunday and Monday due to heavy rain.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
