

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of the Midlands, North and East of England on Monday and Tuesday. Minor inland flooding impacts more widely across England and Wales. The overall flood risk is LOW.





Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Monday) and Tuesday.

Widespread heavy rainfall gives the potential for localised significant surface water flooding impacts in parts of England, with minor impacts probable more widely over England and Wales on Monday and early Tuesday morning. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is LOW today (Monday) and Tuesday.

Following recent rainfall, minor ongoing river flooding impacts are expected in parts of England today (Monday). Further rainfall today and early morning Tuesday gives the potential for further minor river flooding impacts across parts of England and Wales. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
