

















Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW for today (Tuesday).

Localised minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in South East England today. Localised minor surface water flooding impacts are possible elsewhere in England and Wales today and in parts of Northern England on Wednesday.

See Specific Areas of concern maps.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Localised minor river flooding impacts are possible in parts of the North East, North and South East of England today and tomorrow. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across other parts of England and Wales today and in parts of South East England tomorrow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minimal coastal flooding impacts are expected along parts of the East Coast on Wednesday and Thursday due to strong northerly flow potentially generating large shoreward directed waves, which may lead to overtopping.




Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
