



Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected late Tuesday and through Wednesday across parts of England and Wales. Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable on Friday and Saturday. The overall flood risk is LOW.










Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Wednesday 16 and Thursday 17 October 2024

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Tuesday) and Wednesday.

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected later this evening and during Wednesday for parts of North West and South West England, Wales and the West Midlands. Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible more widely until the early hours of Thursday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW on Friday and Saturday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable for Welsh coasts and West coasts of England on Friday and Saturday. Impacts are also possible along the South coast of England and are possible but not expected for the North East and Yorkshire coastline, including the tidal Trent, and parts of East of England coast. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 3.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible for parts of the South Wales coastline and possible but not expected for the South Cornwall coast on Wednesday and Thursday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 2.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible later this evening, during Wednesday and into the early hours of Thursday across parts of England and Wales. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
