



Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected today (Wednesday) across parts of England and Wales. Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable from Friday until Sunday. The overall flood risk is LOW.










### Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Wednesday 16 and Thursday 17 October 2024





### Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Friday 18 October 2024
















### Specific Areas of Concern Map 4 - Saturday 19 October 2024

### Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Wednesday).

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected today for parts of the North and South West of England, Wales and the Midlands. Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible more widely today and across the North of England and Wales until the early hours of Thursday morning. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible but not expected during Saturday for parts of England.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



### Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW from Friday to Sunday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable for some Welsh coasts and North West and South West coasts of England from Friday until Sunday. Impacts are also possible more widely for England and Wales coasts in this period. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps 3, 4 and 5.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible in other locations (See Specific Areas of Concern Map 2) and possible but not expected along other English coasts on Wednesday and Thursday.



#### Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible during Wednesday and into the early hours of Thursday across parts of England and Wales. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected during Saturday across parts of England with heavy rain falling on wet catchments.



### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



### **Summary of potential impacts**

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
