








## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 18 October 2024





















### Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Saturday 19 October 2024


















#### Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW today.

Minor river flooding is expected today (Thursday) across parts of Wales and the West of England, as rivers continue to respond following heavy rain yesterday. Ongoing river flooding is then possible along the River Severn until Sunday.

Further river flooding is possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales today, and from Friday evening through into Saturday, due to heavy rain.



### Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW from Friday to Sunday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable for some Welsh coasts and North West and South West coasts of England from Friday until Sunday. Impacts are also possible more widely for England and Wales coasts in this period. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible in other locations (See Specific Areas of Concern Map) and possible but not expected along other English coasts on Thursday.



#### Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Surface water flooding is possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales from Friday evening through into Saturday, due to heavy rain.



### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



#### **Summary of potential impacts**

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
