


A working partnership between






Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Sunday 20 October 2024













Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Monday 21 October 2024
















Specific Areas of Concern Map 4 - Tuesday 22 October 2024







Coastal/tidal flooding probable around times of high water.

Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW from Saturday to Monday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable in places and possible more widely from Saturday until Tuesday. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Ongoing river flooding is possible along the River Severn until Wednesday. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Due to recent and forecast rainfall, minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected across parts of Wales today (Saturday) and parts of England from today until Monday.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of England on Monday due to forecast heavy rainfall.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
