



Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW on Saturday and Sunday.

Significant river flooding is possible in parts of England and Wales on Saturday and Sunday due to heavy rain, possibly combined with rapid snowmelt. Minor river flooding is possible more widely across England and Wales, which may continue in places until Tuesday. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales on Wednesday due to further heavy rain.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW on Saturday and Sunday.

Significant surface water flooding is possible in parts of England and Wales on Saturday and Sunday due to heavy rain possibly combined with rapid snowmelt. Minor surface water flooding is possible more widely across England and Wales. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales on Wednesday due to further heavy rain.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
