













## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Wednesday 27 November 2024 (Zoomed In)




















## Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Thursday 28 and Friday 29 November 2024

#### Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is MEDIUM today (Wednesday) and LOW until Friday.

Significant river flooding impacts are probable in parts of Northamptonshire today. Minor river flooding is expected in parts of Northamptonshire tomorrow, and probable on parts of the Severn until Friday as the peak moves downstream over the next few days. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Additional minor river flooding impacts are also probable in parts of the South and East of England today, and possible elsewhere across parts of England following further heavy rain overnight last night. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



#### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Dorset and Wiltshire from Friday onwards due to rising groundwater levels from recent heavy rainfall.



### Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



### Coastal/Tidal


The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

### Flood risk matrix



#### **Summary of potential impacts**

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
