


Minor river flooding impacts are expected on the River Severn until Thursday following heavy rain from Storm Darragh. The overall flood risk is LOW.





Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW until Thursday.

Ongoing minor flooding impacts are expected along parts of the River Severn until Thursday. This is due to the recent heavy rain associated with Storm Darragh.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible in parts of Dorset, Wiltshire and Hampshire from today (Tuesday) until Thursday due to high groundwater levels. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.

🖸 Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
