



Minor inland flooding impacts are probable in parts of England and Wales, and possible more widely, today into Monday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Inland flooding impacts due to persistent precipitation and snowmelt in places.

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW for today (Sunday) and Monday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of England and Wales, and possible more widely, today (Sunday) and Monday due to heavy rain and melting snow. See Areas of Concern Map.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of the south of England on Wednesday and Thursday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk LOW for today (Sunday) and Monday.

Minor river flooding impacts are probable in parts of the North West of England and possible more widely across England and Wales today into Monday due to heavy rain and melting snow. See Areas of Concern Map.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Wales and the Midlands on Tuesday and the south of England on Wednesday and Thursday.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal impacts are possible but not expected on exposed parts of the east coast of England during the evening tides today (Sunday) and on Monday.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
