


Minor coastal/tidal flooding impacts are probable for parts of Norfolk on Sunday and possible more widely for parts of England on Sunday and into early Monday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW on Sunday.

Minor coastal/tidal flooding impacts are probable for parts of the Norfolk coast on Sunday and are possible more widely for the English coast on Sunday, continuing into the early hours of Monday for the South coast of England. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor coastal/tidal flooding impacts are also possible but not expected more widely for some coasts of England and Wales between Saturday and Tuesday.

This is due to high spring tides coupled with storm surge.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
