



Significant surface water impacts are probable on Saturday due to heavy showers and thunderstorms. The overall flood risk for England and Wales is MEDIUM on Saturday.











Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Saturday 19 July 2025






Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Sunday 20 and Monday 21 July 2025

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is MEDIUM on Saturday and LOW on Sunday and Monday.

Significant surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of the South and East of England and London and possible more widely across England on Saturday due to heavy showers and thunderstorms.

Significant surface water flooding impacts are also possible in parts of South West England with minor impacts possible more widely on Sunday and Monday, again due to slow moving heavy showers and thunderstorms.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of the North, South and East of England and London on Friday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across the whole of England and Wales on Sunday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Isolated minor river impacts are possible but not expected on Saturday should a heavy thunderstorm catch some river catchments.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
