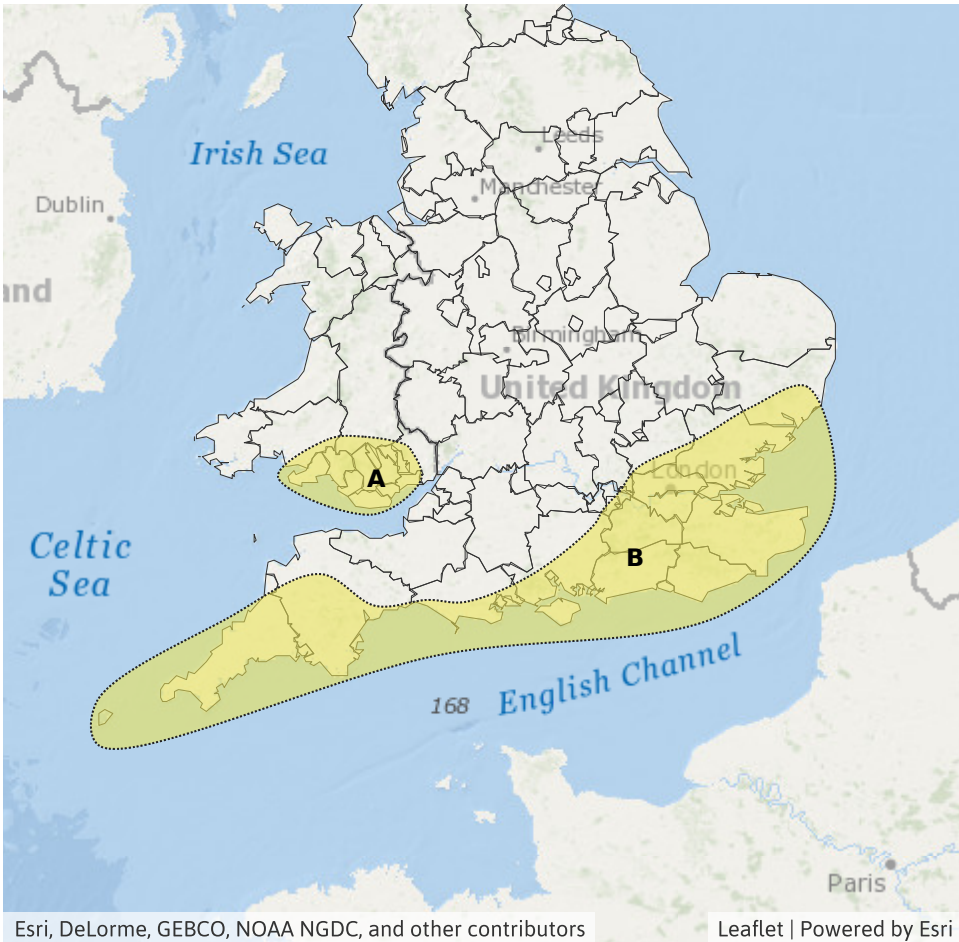

## Assessment of flood risk



### Surface water

---

The surface water flood risk is **LOW** today (Thursday) and Friday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable across parts of Wales and England today (Thursday) and on Friday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across other parts of England and Wales today (Thursday) as a result of localised heavy and persistent showers.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



### Rivers

---

The river flood risk is **VERY LOW** for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of England on Friday as a result of a band of rain and showers.



### Coastal/Tidal

---

The coastal/tidal flood risk is **VERY LOW** for the next five days.

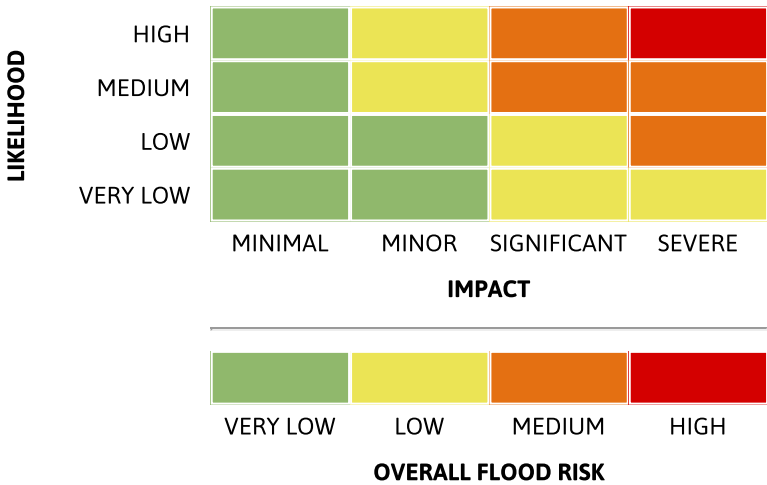


### Groundwater

---

The groundwater flood risk is **VERY LOW** for the next five days.

## Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**  
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**  
Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**  
Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**  
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
