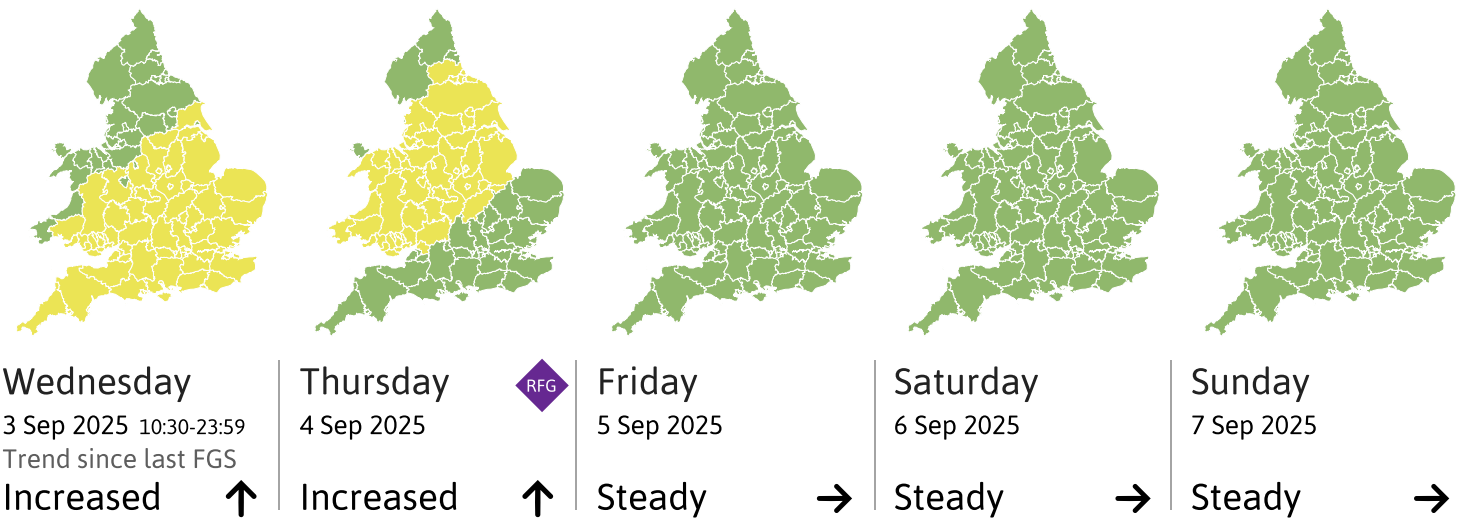


Flood Guidance Statement

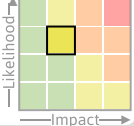
10:30hrs Wednesday 03 September 2025



Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales on Thursday, with minor surface water flooding probable today (Wednesday). The overall flood risk for England and Wales is LOW.

Likelihood **MEDIUM**

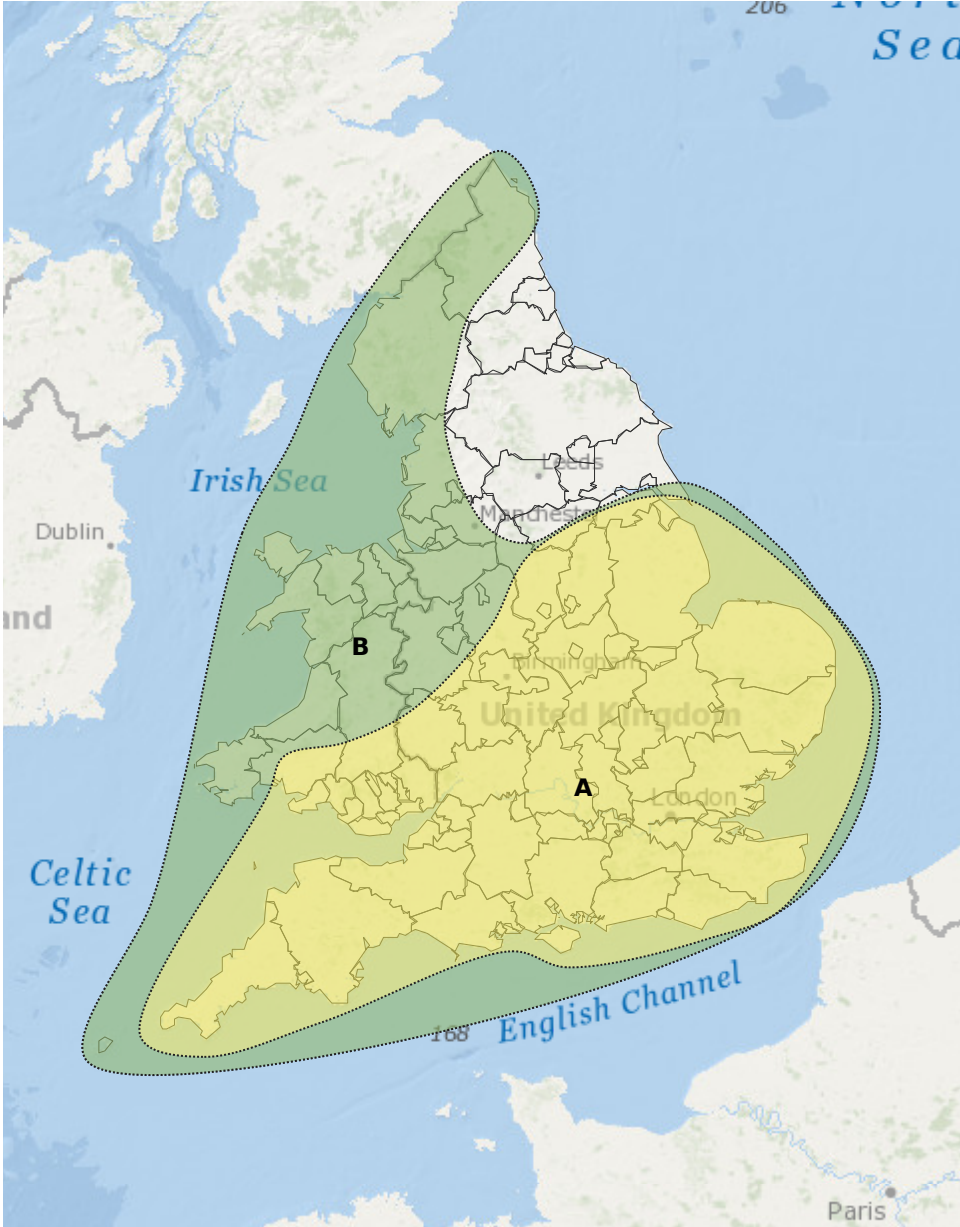

Likelihood **VERY LOW**

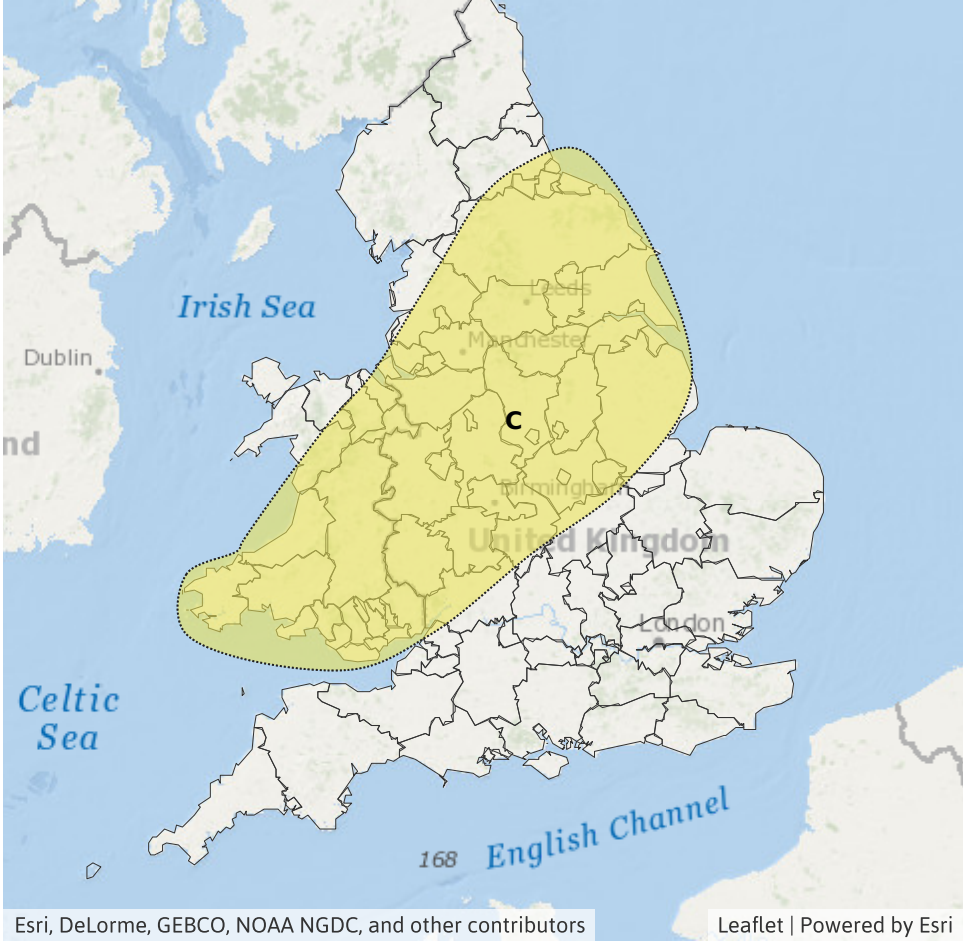

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Wednesday) and on Thursday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable across parts of England and Wales and possible more widely today. This is due to areas of persistent heavy rain and thundery showers. See area of concern map for details.

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales on Thursday. This is due to an area of slow moving showers. See area of concern map for details.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

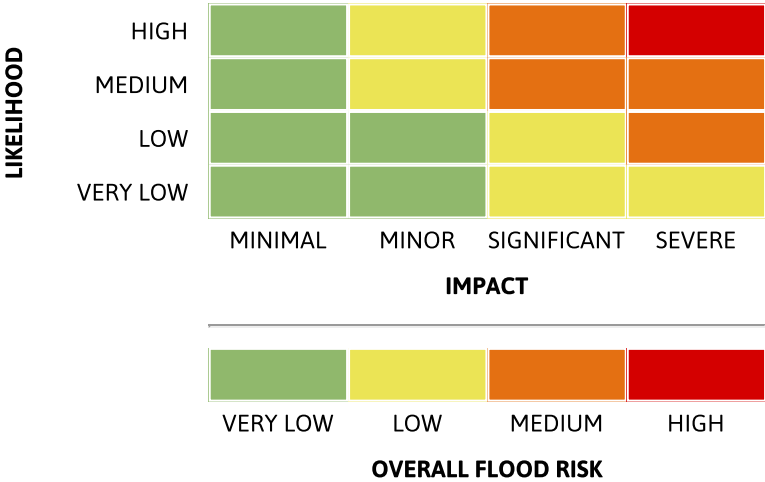
The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**
Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**
Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
