

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW on Wednesday (tomorrow).

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of Wales and possible more widely in Wales from the early hours of the morning on Wednesday. This is due to the risk of heavy and persistent rain. See Area of concern map for details.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in Wales on Thursday due to the risk of further outbreaks of heavy rain on wet ground.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible in parts of Wales from the early hours of the morning on Wednesday due to a risk of heavy and persistent rain.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Wales on Thursday due to the risk of further outbreaks of heavy rain over wet catchments.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
