



Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable across parts of the North of England on Friday. The overall flood risk for England is LOW.




Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Saturday 04 to Sunday 05 October 2025

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW for Friday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of the North of England and possible across Wales and more widely across the North of England on Friday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map for details.

Isolated minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible but not expected more widely across England and Wales on Friday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible in parts of the North of England and Wales on Friday and Saturday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map for detail.

Isolated minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected more widely across England and Wales on Friday and Saturday.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible in the East of England on Saturday and on Sunday due to tide locking, high tides and a storm surge. See Specific Areas of Concern Map for details.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
