



Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible today (Sunday) and possible but not expected tomorrow across parts of England and Wales. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible today (Sunday) for parts of England and Wales, and are possible but not expected more widely due to heavy and persistent rain. See Specific Areas of Concern Map for more details.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected tomorrow for parts of England and Wales due to a risk of isolated heavy showers.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected from late Wednesday and on Thursday for parts of England and Wales due to a risk of rain and showers.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected from late Wednesday and on Thursday for parts of England and Wales due to a risk of rain and showers.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minimal coastal flooding impacts are possible in England and Wales on Thursday due to high tides and unsettled coastal conditions including large waves and surge. Impacts may include isolated spray on low-lying roads and coastal promenades.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
