



Significant river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in the North of England on Monday and Tuesday. Significant coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected in the South West of England on Wednesday. The overall flood risk is LOW.










Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Wednesday 5 November 2025

Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW for Monday and Tuesday.

Significant river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of the North of England on Monday and Tuesday.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible for parts of the North of England and North Wales on Monday and Tuesday, and possible but not expected more widely across parts of England and Wales from Monday to Wednesday.

Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW on Wednesday.

Significant coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected in the South West of England around the afternoon tide on Wednesday with spring tides combining with storm surge and perhaps gales and large waves.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible more widely along the coasts of England and Wales on Wednesday. Refer to the Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minimal coastal impacts are also expected along some English coasts on Wednesday. Impacts may include isolated spray on low-lying roads and coastal promenades.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding is possible for parts of the North of England and North Wales on Monday and Tuesday, and possible but not expected more widely across parts of England and Wales from Monday to Wednesday. Refer to the Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.


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Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
