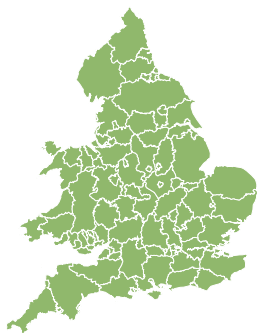

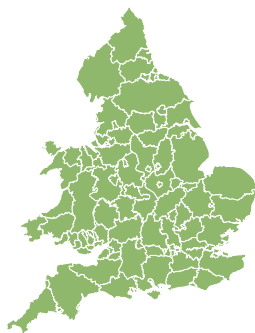

Trend since last FGS

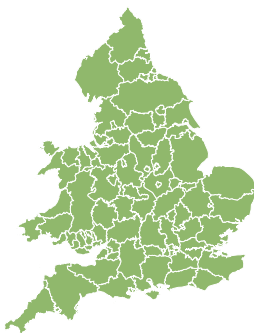

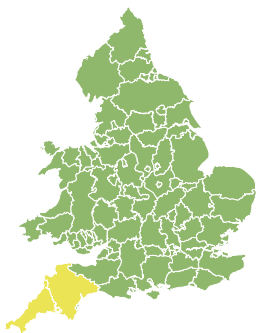

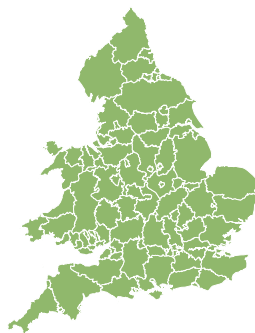

Significant coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected in the South West of England on Wednesday. Minor inland and coastal flooding impacts are possible at other times. The overall flood risk is LOW.

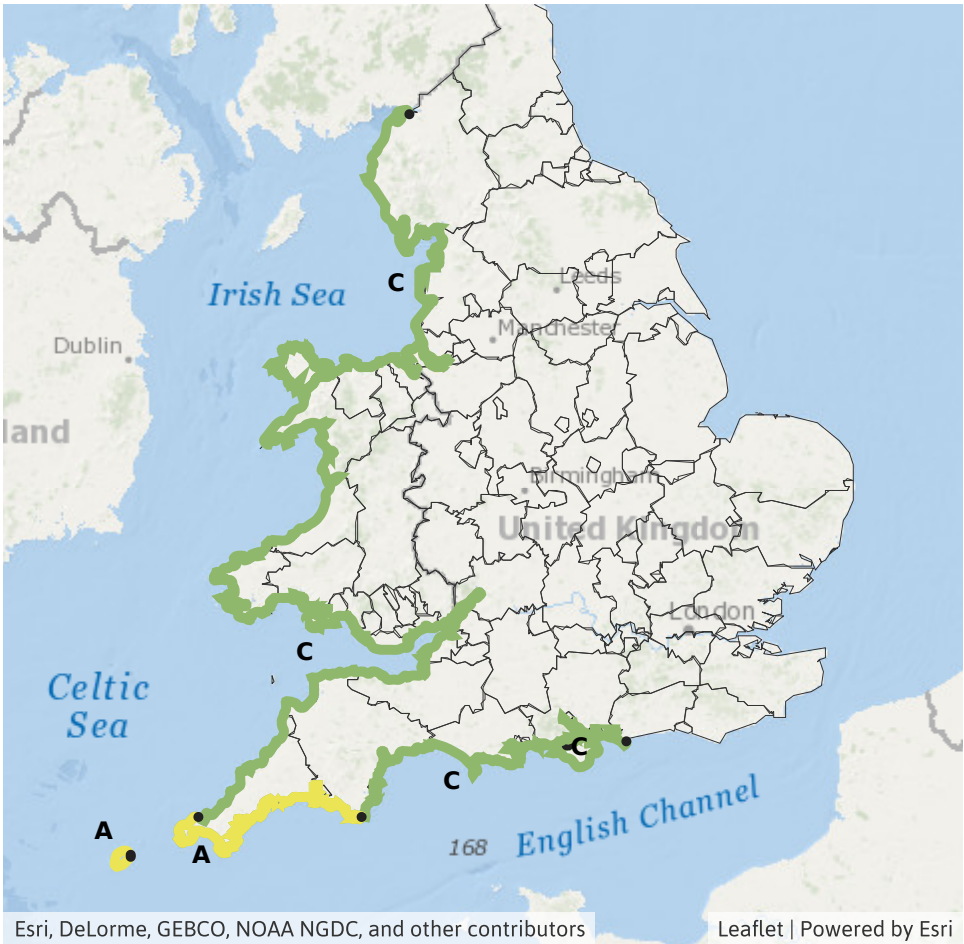
Source Coastal/Tidal

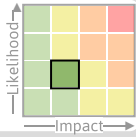

Impact **MINOR**

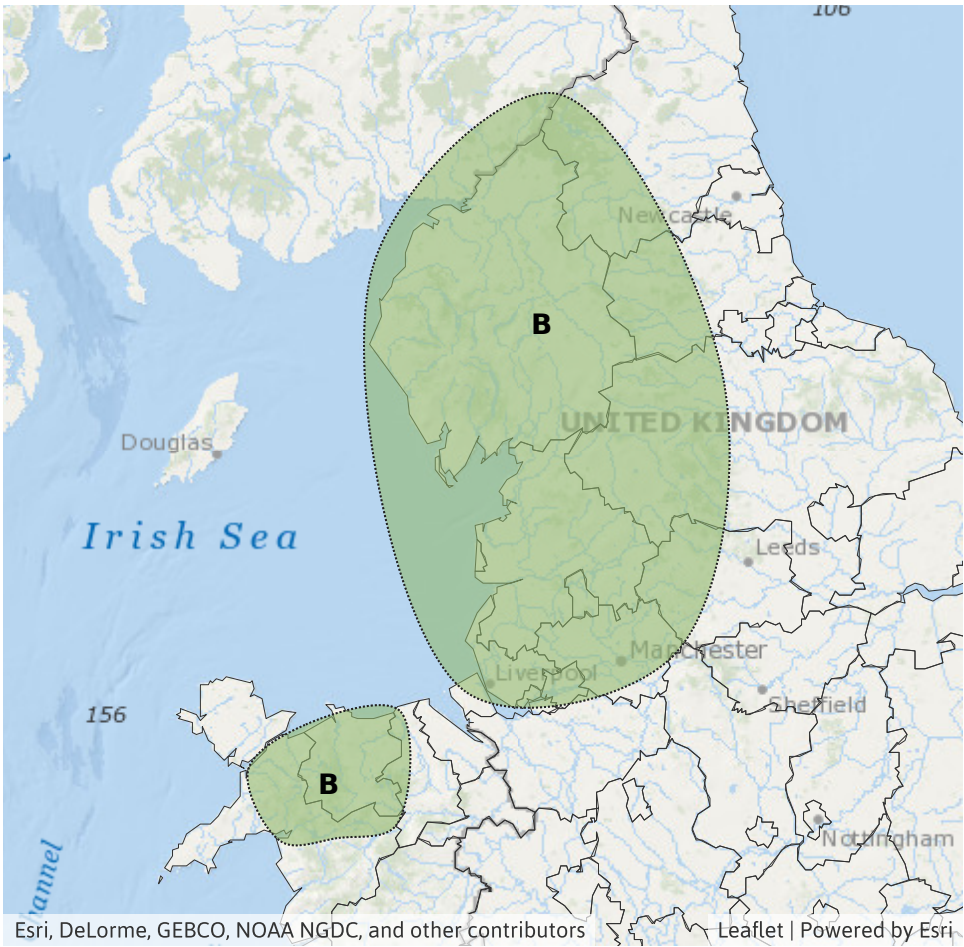
Likelihood **LOW**

Continuous rain on Monday and Tuesday.



Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW on Wednesday.

Significant coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England on Wednesday, with minor impacts possible along other coasts of England and Wales through Wednesday and Thursday. Refer to the Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected more widely along coasts of England on Wednesday and Thursday.

Minimal coastal impacts are also expected along some English coasts on Wednesday and Thursday. Impacts may include isolated spray on low-lying roads and coastal promenades.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for Monday and Tuesday.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible for parts of England and Wales on Monday and Tuesday, and possible but not expected more widely across parts of England and Wales from Monday to Wednesday.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding is possible for parts of England and Wales on Monday and Tuesday, and possible but not expected more widely across parts of England and Wales from Monday to Wednesday. Refer to the Specific Areas of Concern Map.

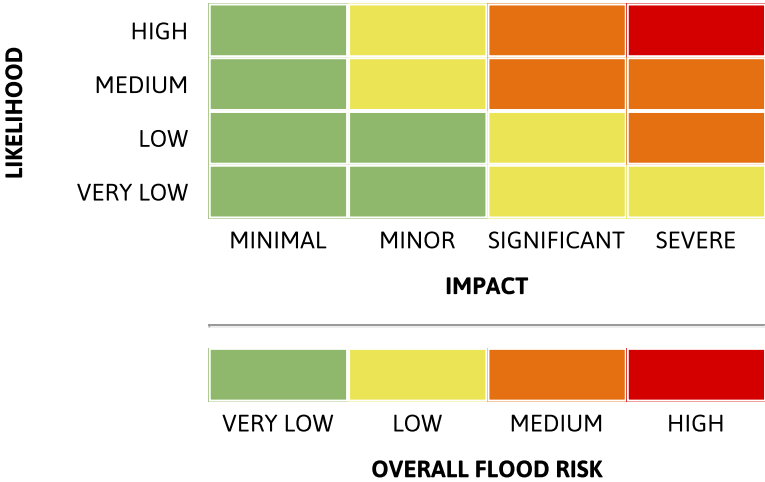
Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**
Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**
Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
