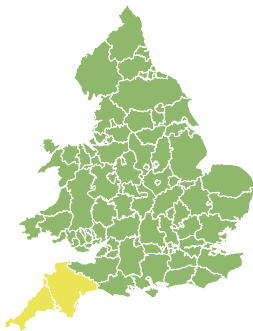

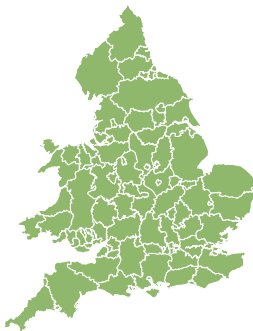

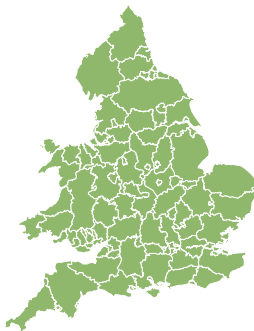

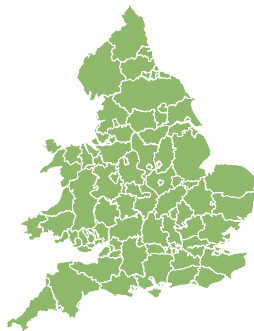

Impact **MINOR**

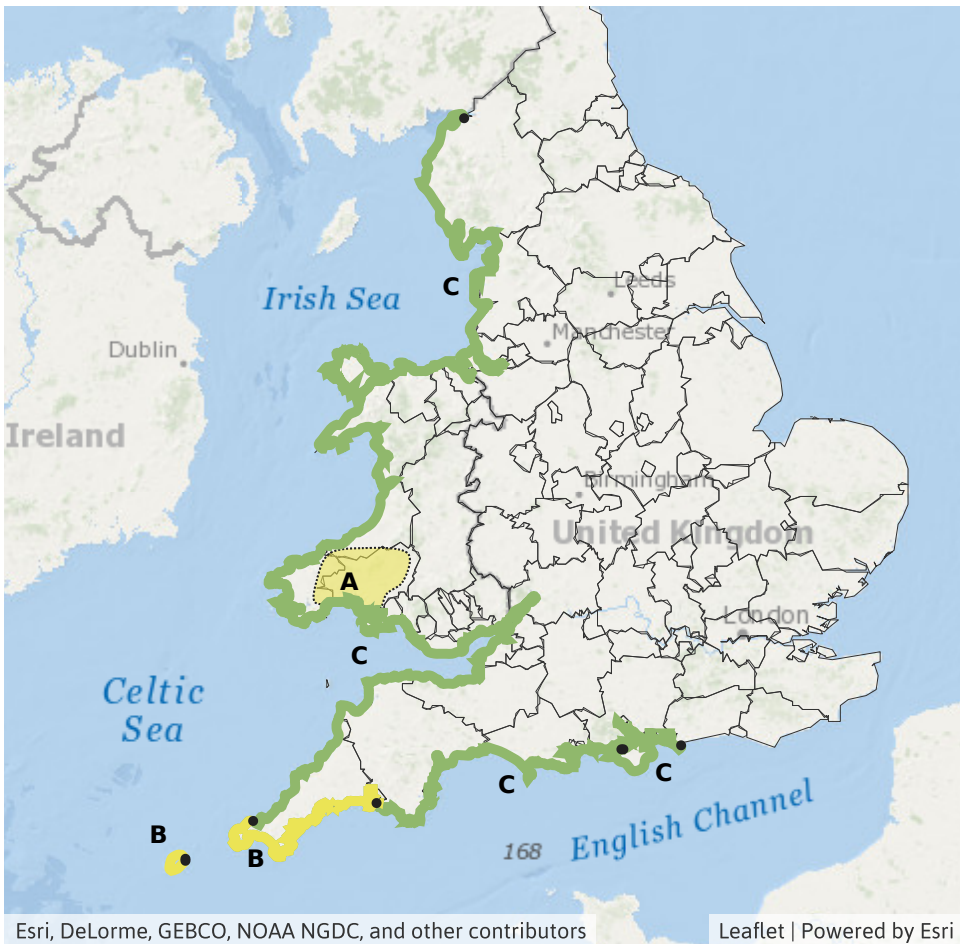
Likelihood **LOW**

Spring tides and unsettled weather at times may lead to minor coastal flooding impacts



Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW today (Wednesday) and Thursday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are expected in parts of South West England near times of high water today and tomorrow morning. Minor impacts are possible along other coasts of England and Wales through today and Thursday. Refer to the Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected more widely along coasts of England and Wales from Wednesday to Friday.



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW today (Wednesday).

Minor river flooding impacts are probable in parts of South West Wales today (Wednesday) and possible but not expected in some parts of England today due to recent prolonged heavy rain. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.



Surface water

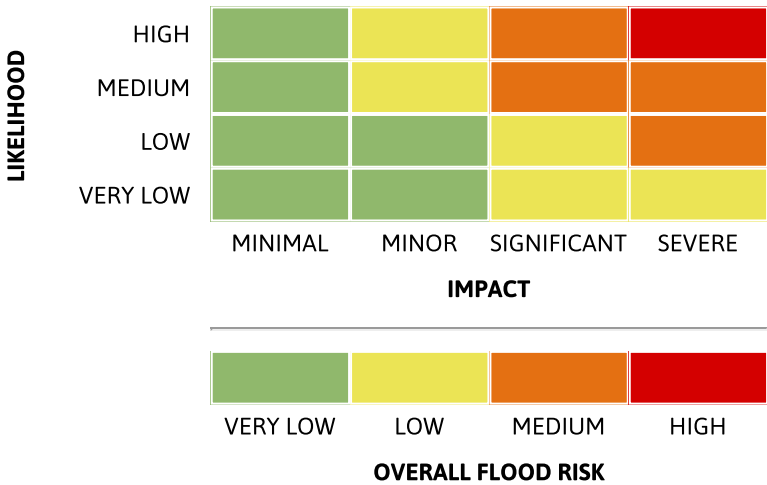
The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**
Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**
Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
