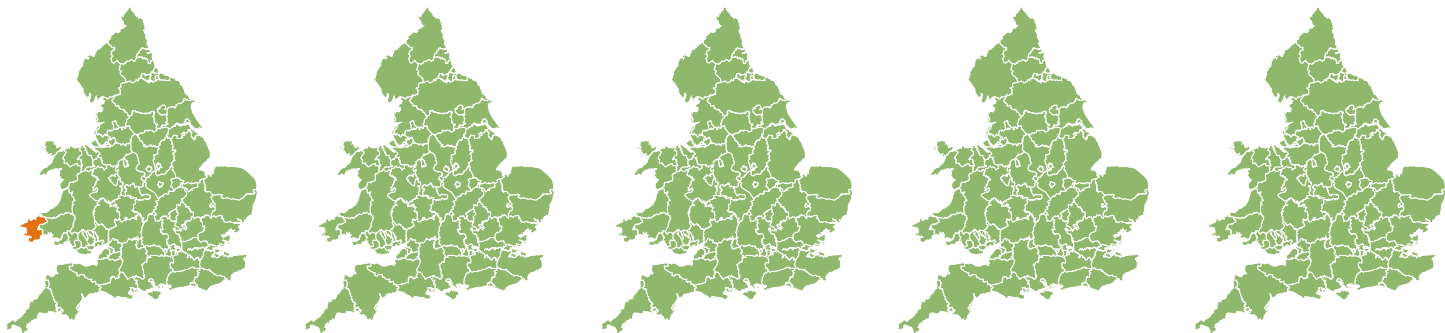

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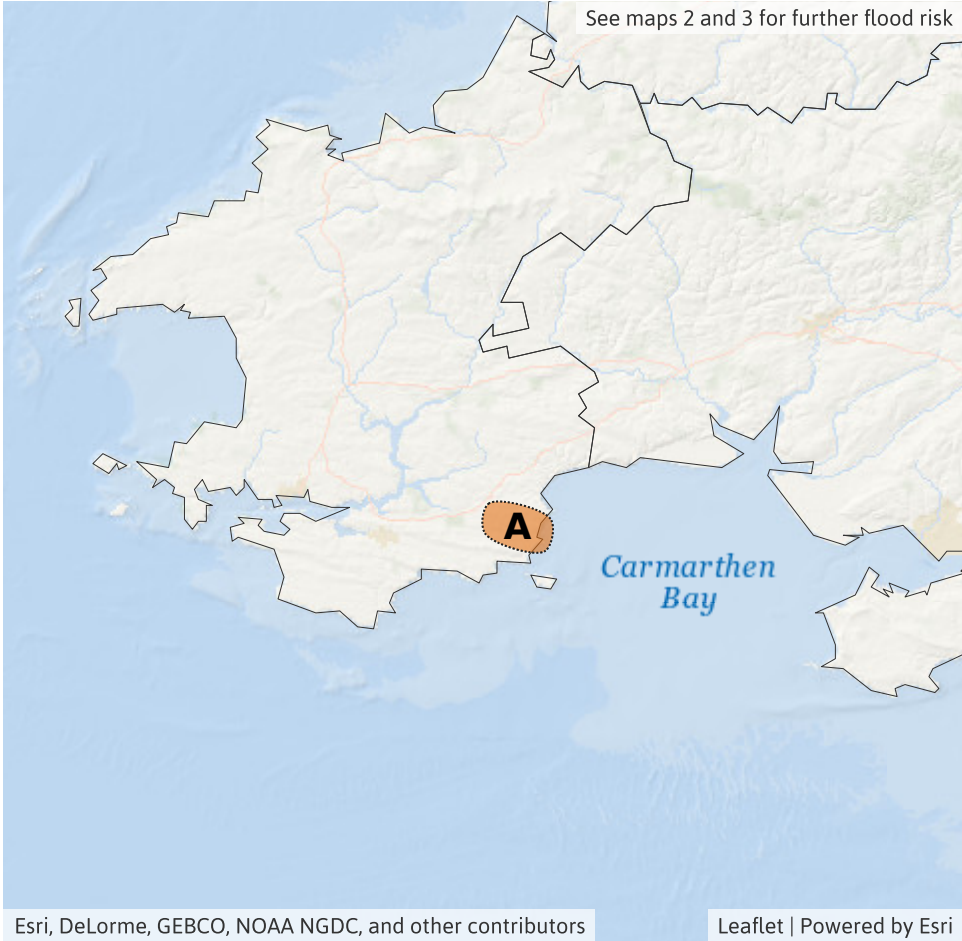
Significant coastal and river flooding impacts are expected in Pembrokeshire today (Thursday). Minor inland and coastal flooding impacts are possible elsewhere in Wales and across parts of England today. The overall flood risk is MEDIUM.

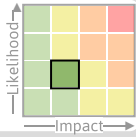

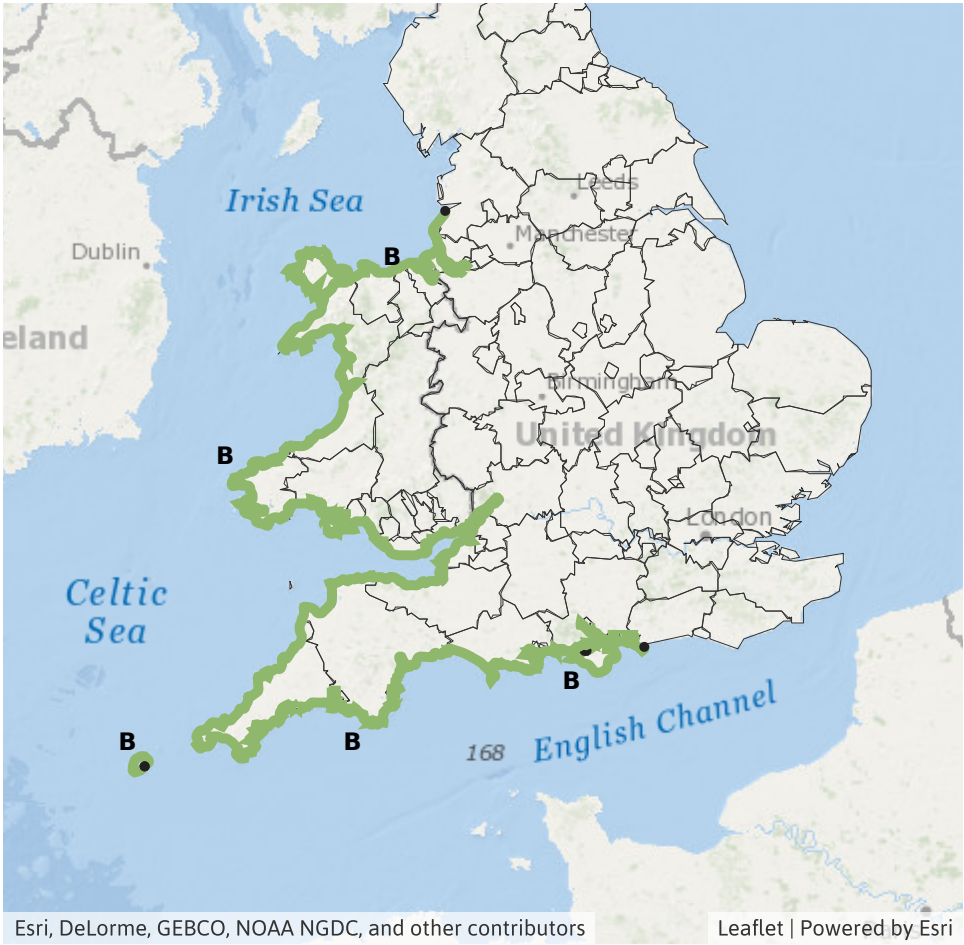
Likelihood **LOW**

Spring tides and unsettled weather at times may lead to minor coastal flooding impacts.

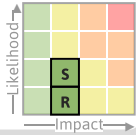


Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Thursday 6 November 2025

Impact **MINOR**

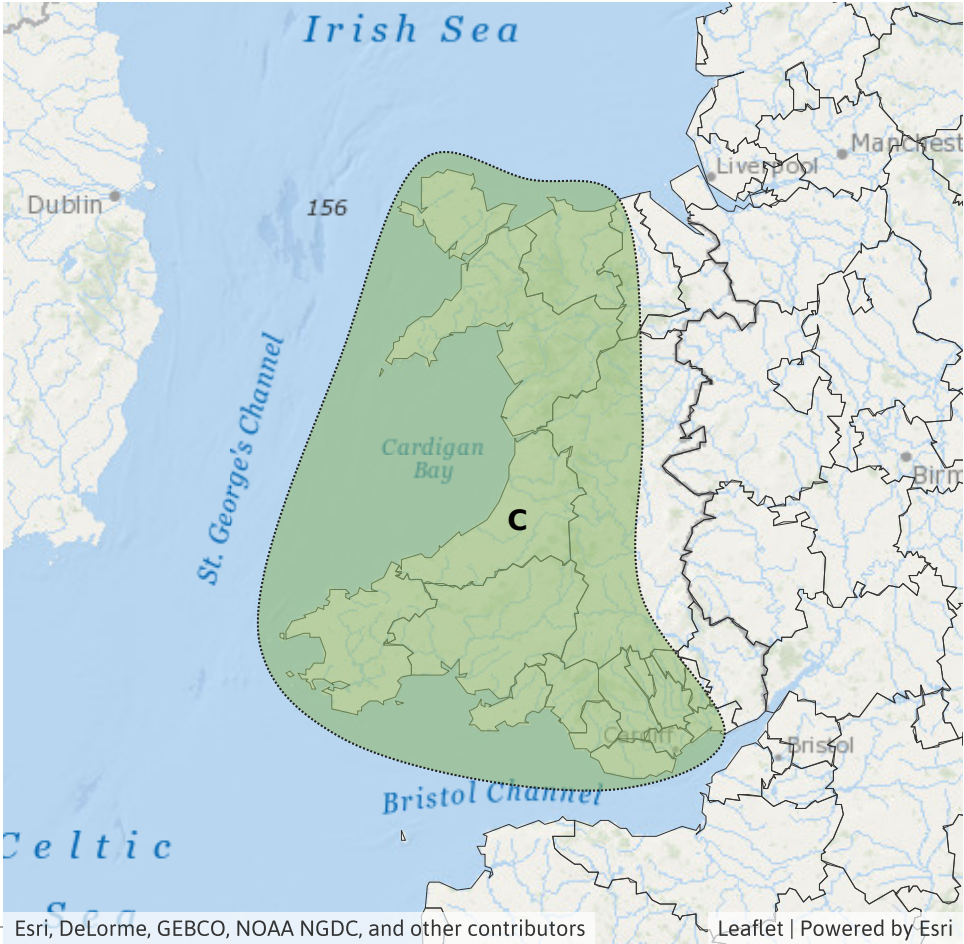
Likelihood **LOW**

Localised heavy rain falling on sensitive ground may result in flooding impacts.



Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is MEDIUM today (Thursday).

Significant coastal flooding impacts are expected for Tenby, Pembrokeshire today. This is due to tide locking, as high tides prevent high river levels from clearing the area. Minor impacts are possible along other coasts of England and Wales through today and tomorrow. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Minimal coastal flooding impacts are expected more widely along coasts of England and Wales today through to Saturday around high tides.



Rivers

The river flood risk is MEDIUM today (Thursday).

Significant river flooding impacts are expected for Tenby, Pembrokeshire today. This is due to tide locking, as high tides prevent high river levels from clearing the area. Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected more widely across Wales today. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

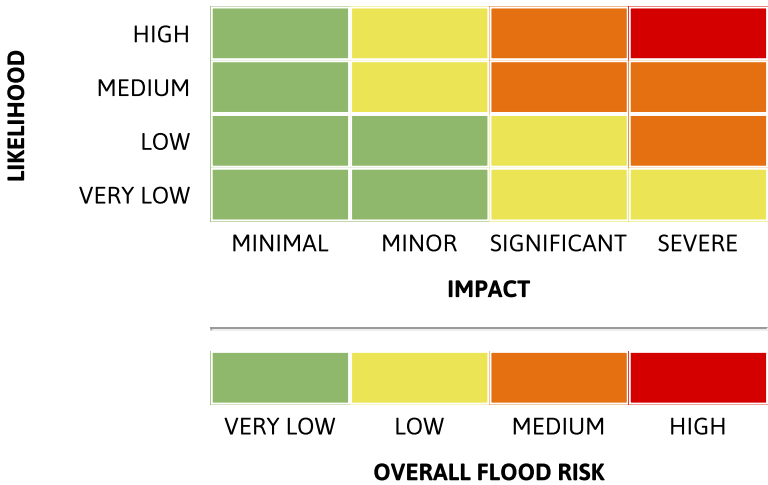
Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible in parts of Wales today (Thursday). See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**
Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**
Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
