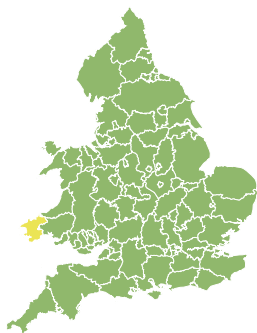

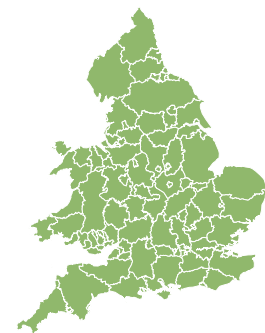

Trend since last FGS

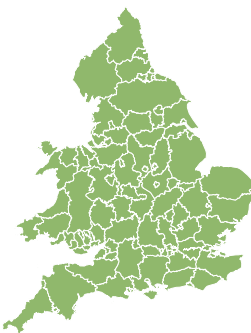

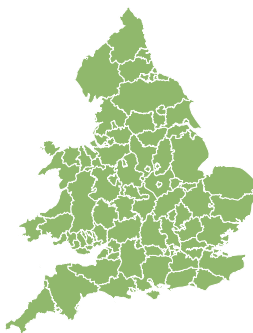

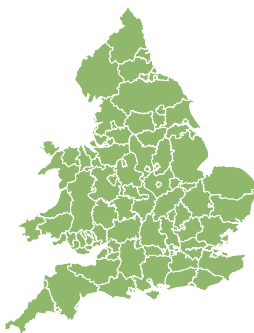

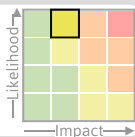

Impact **MINOR**

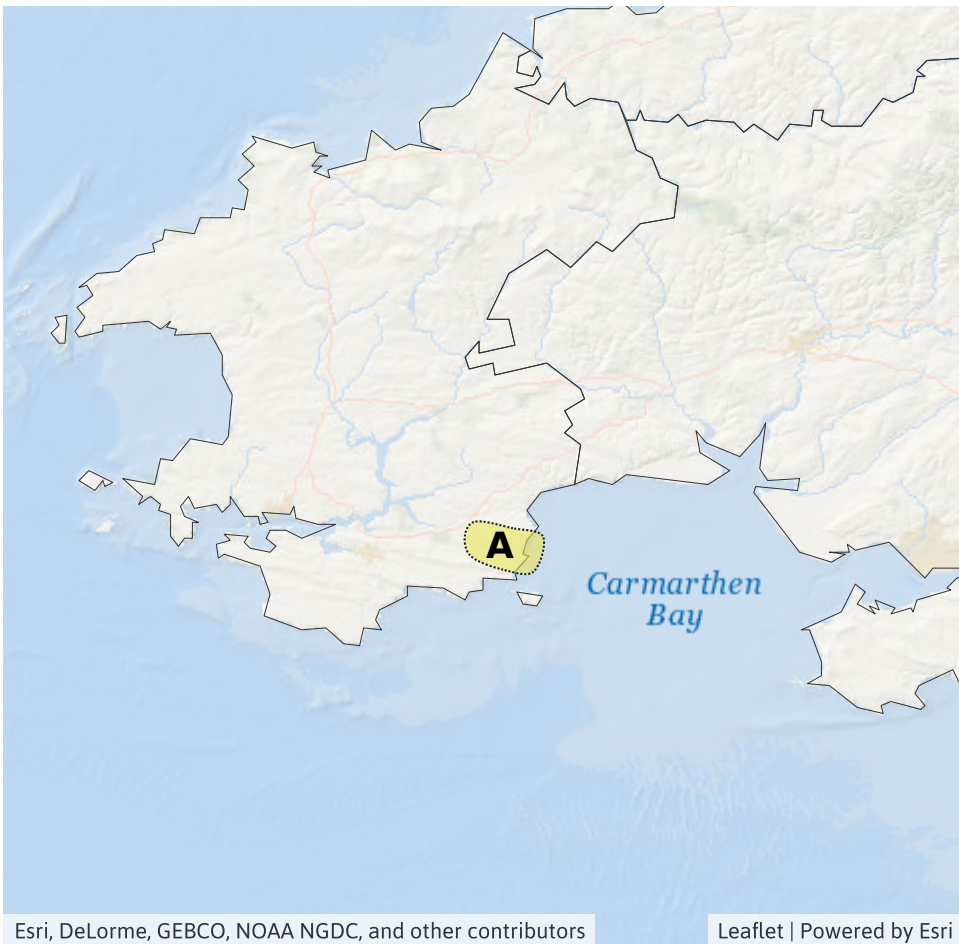

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Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW on Friday (today).

Minor coastal flooding impacts are expected for Tenby, Pembrokeshire today. This is due to tide locking, as high tides will prevent high river levels from clearing the area.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected along parts of the coasts in England and Wales today. Minimal coastal flooding impacts are expected more widely along coasts of England and Wales today and Saturday around high tides.



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW on Friday.

Minor river flooding impacts are expected for Tenby, Pembrokeshire today. This is due to tide locking, as high tides will prevent high river levels from clearing the area.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Wales on Sunday and again on Tuesday.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Wales on Sunday and again on Tuesday.

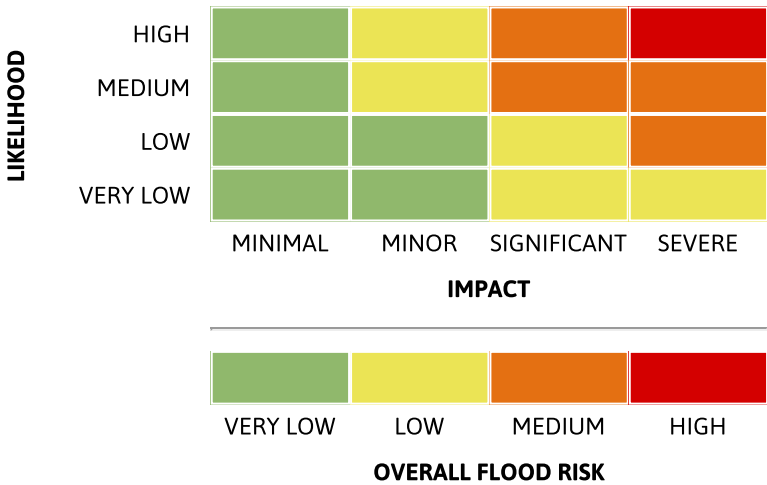
Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**
Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**
Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
