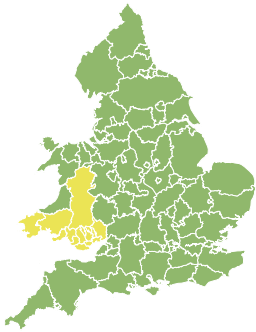

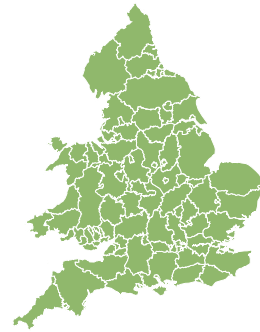

Trend since last FGS

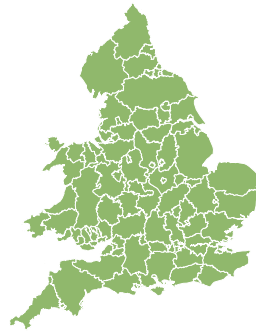

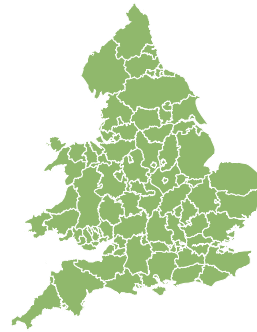

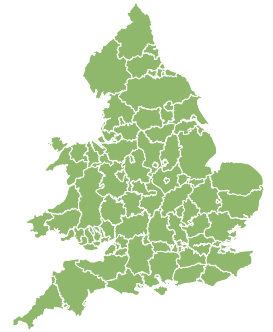

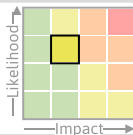
Minor inland flooding impacts are probable for parts of Wales today (Sunday), becoming rivers only impacts into Monday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Likelihood **MEDIUM**



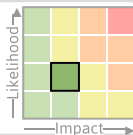
Source River Surface

RISK AREA B

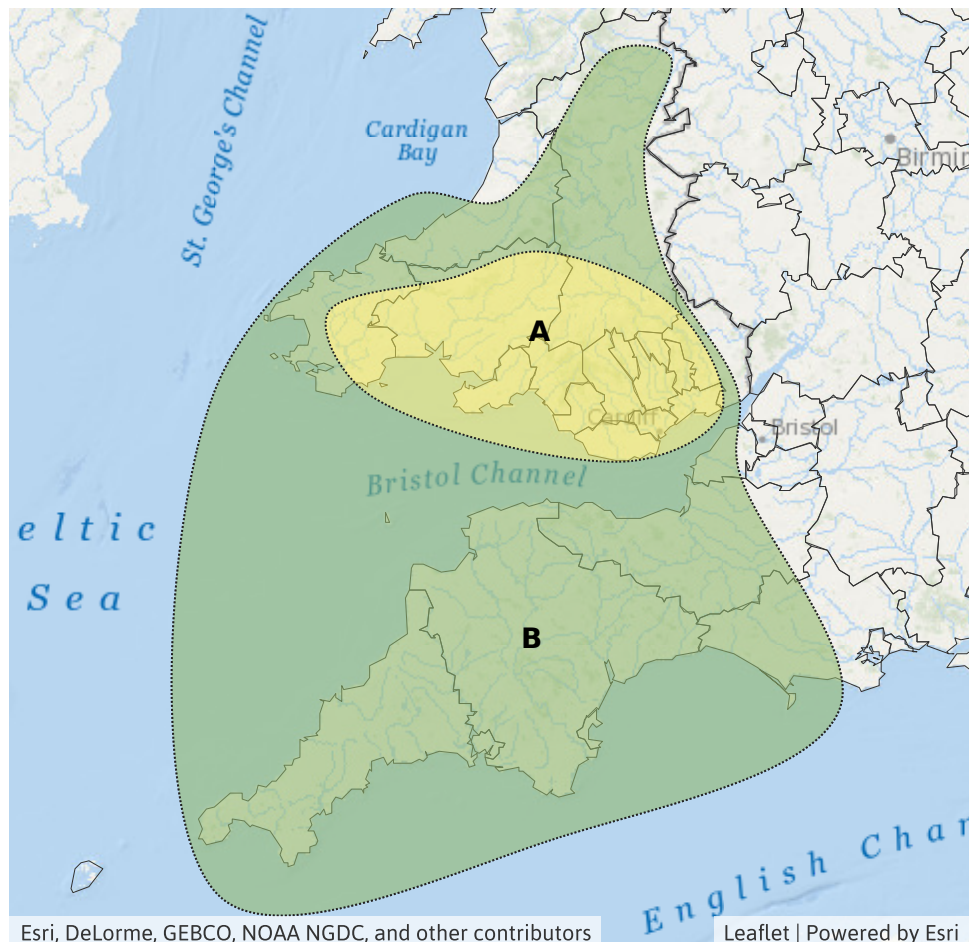
Impact **MINOR**

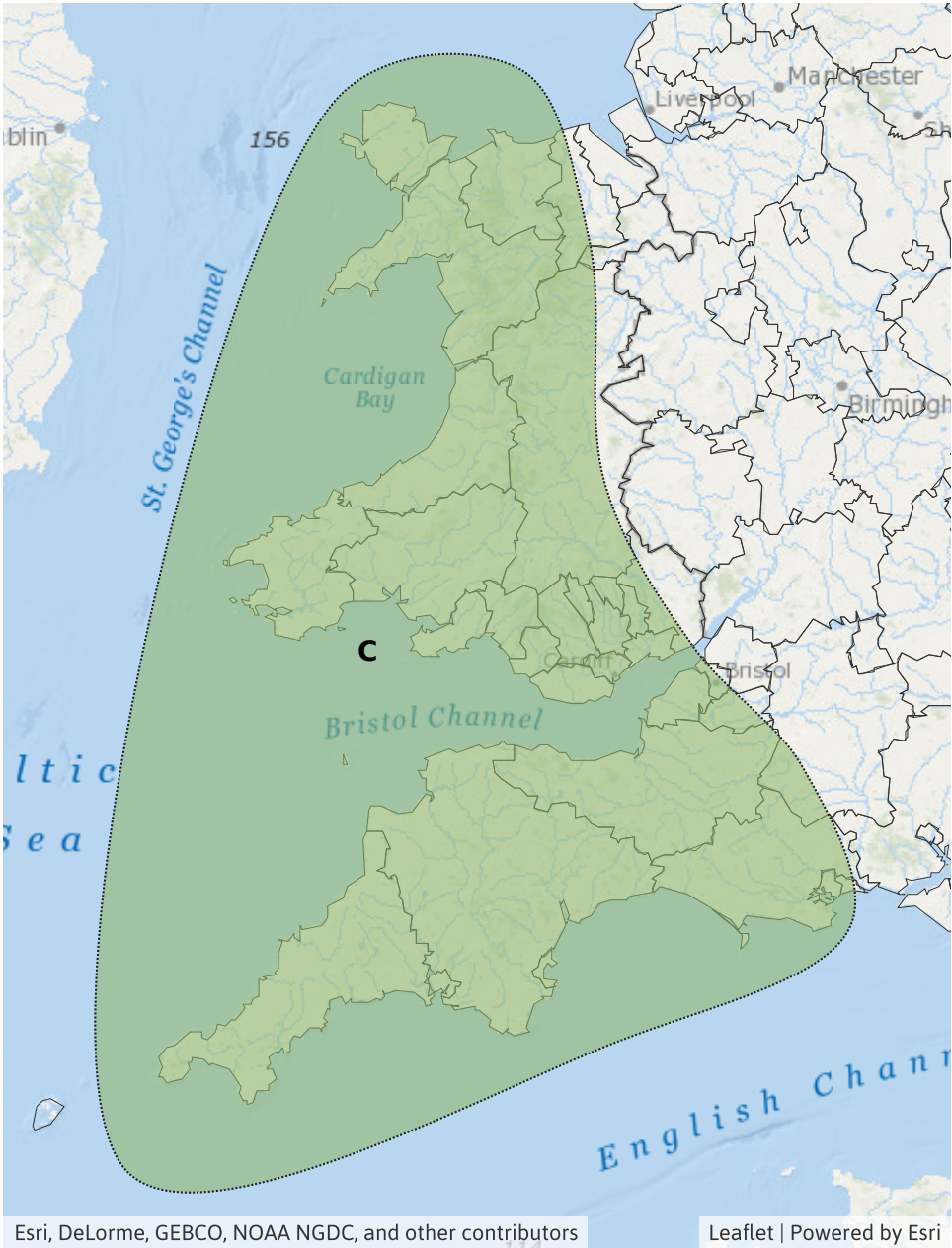

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW today (Sunday).

Minor river flooding impacts are probable in parts of Wales on Sunday. Minor river flooding impacts are also possible more widely across England and Wales on Sunday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Flooding impacts are only possible on Monday in parts of Wales. See Areas of Concern Maps for details.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England and Wales on Monday, and across parts of England on Tuesday and Wednesday.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Sunday).

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of Wales on Sunday. Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible more widely across England and Wales on Sunday, Tuesday and Wednesday. See Areas of Concern Maps for details.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England and Wales on Monday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

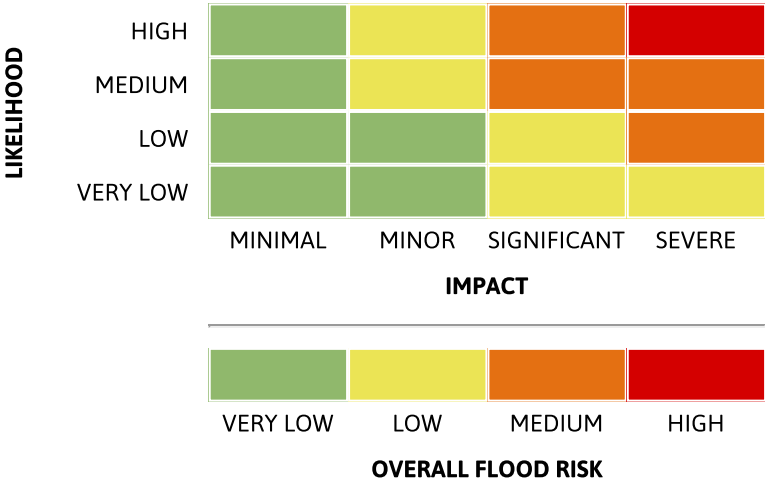
The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**
Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**
Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
