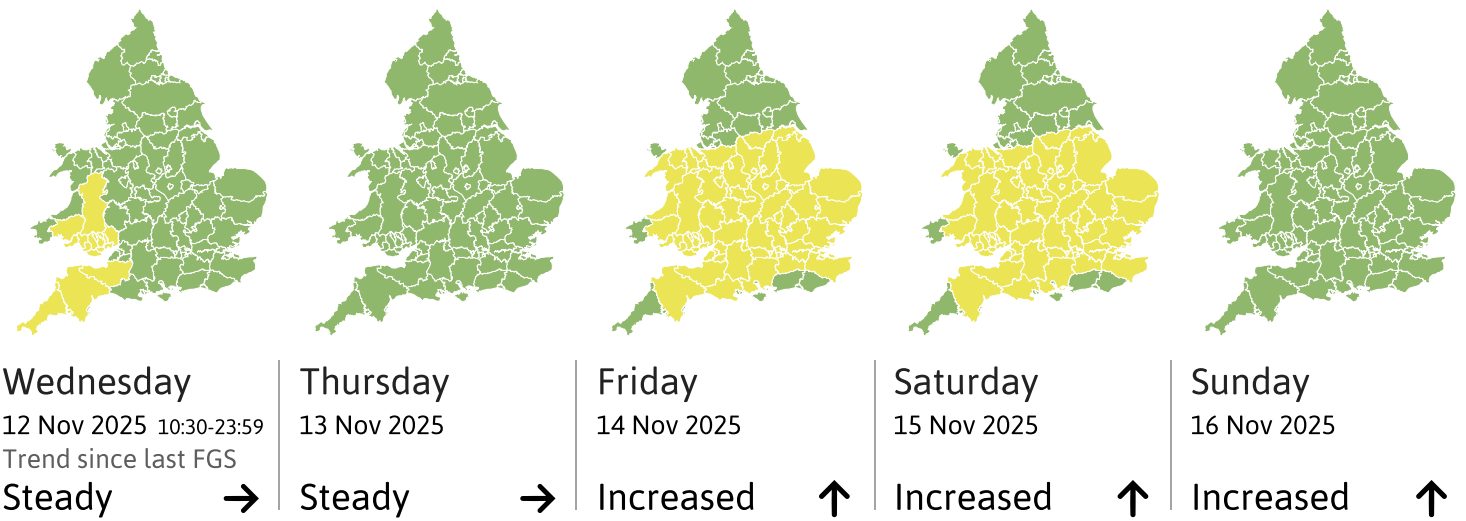


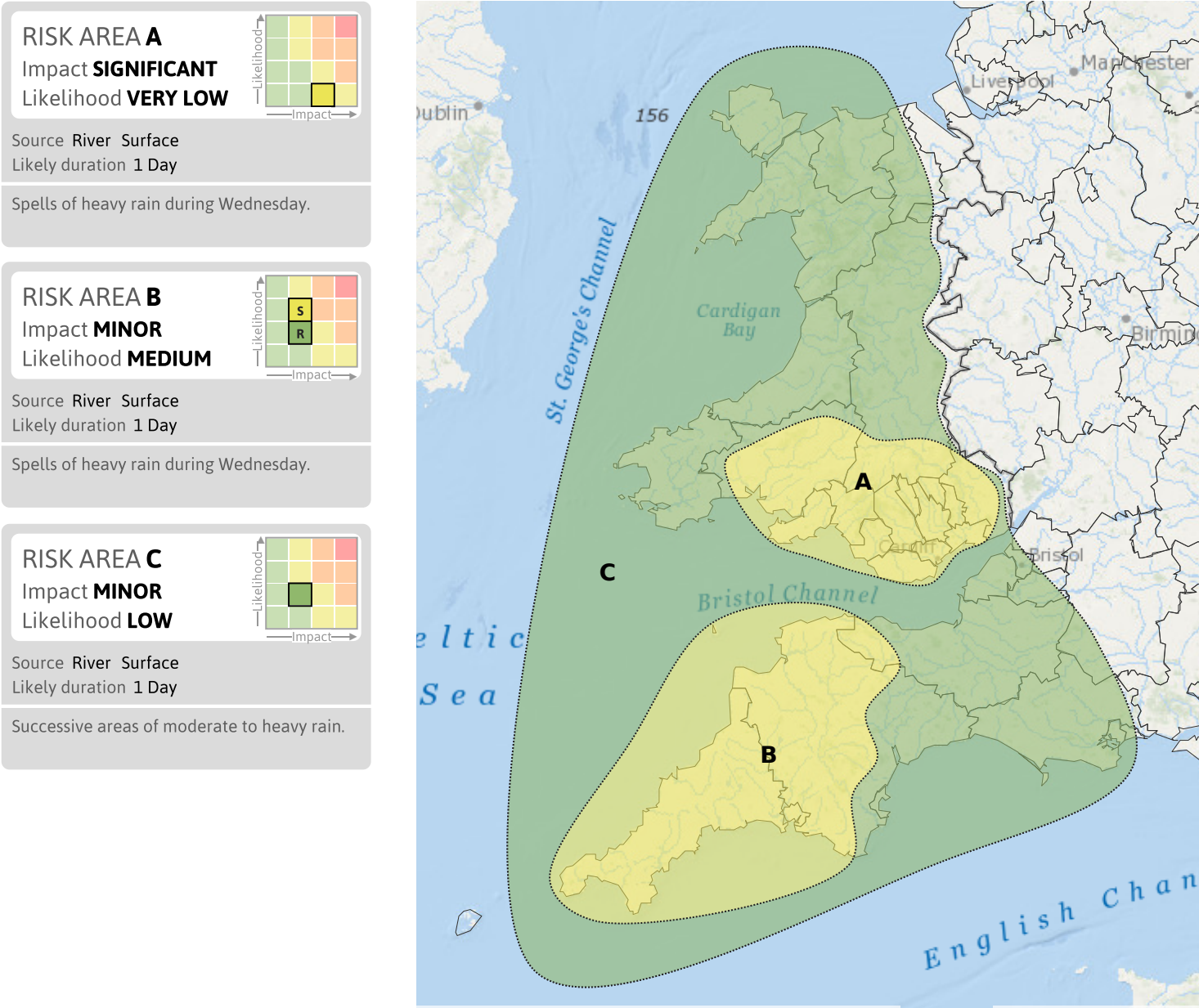
# Flood Guidance Statement

10:30hrs Wednesday 12 November 2025



Significant inland flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of Wales on Wednesday and for parts of England and Wales on Friday and Saturday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

## Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 - Wednesday 12 November 2025

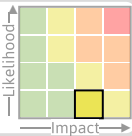


Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 14 November 2025

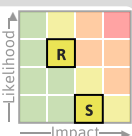

Impact **MINOR**

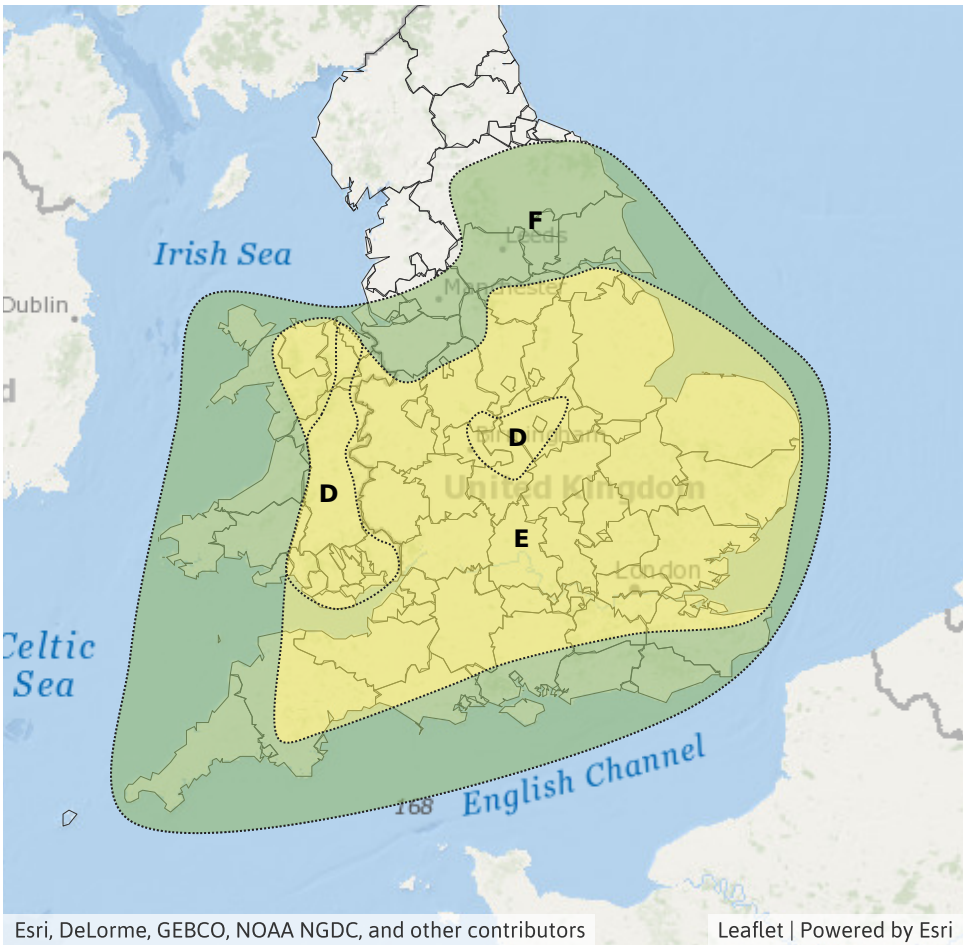

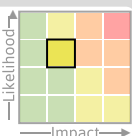

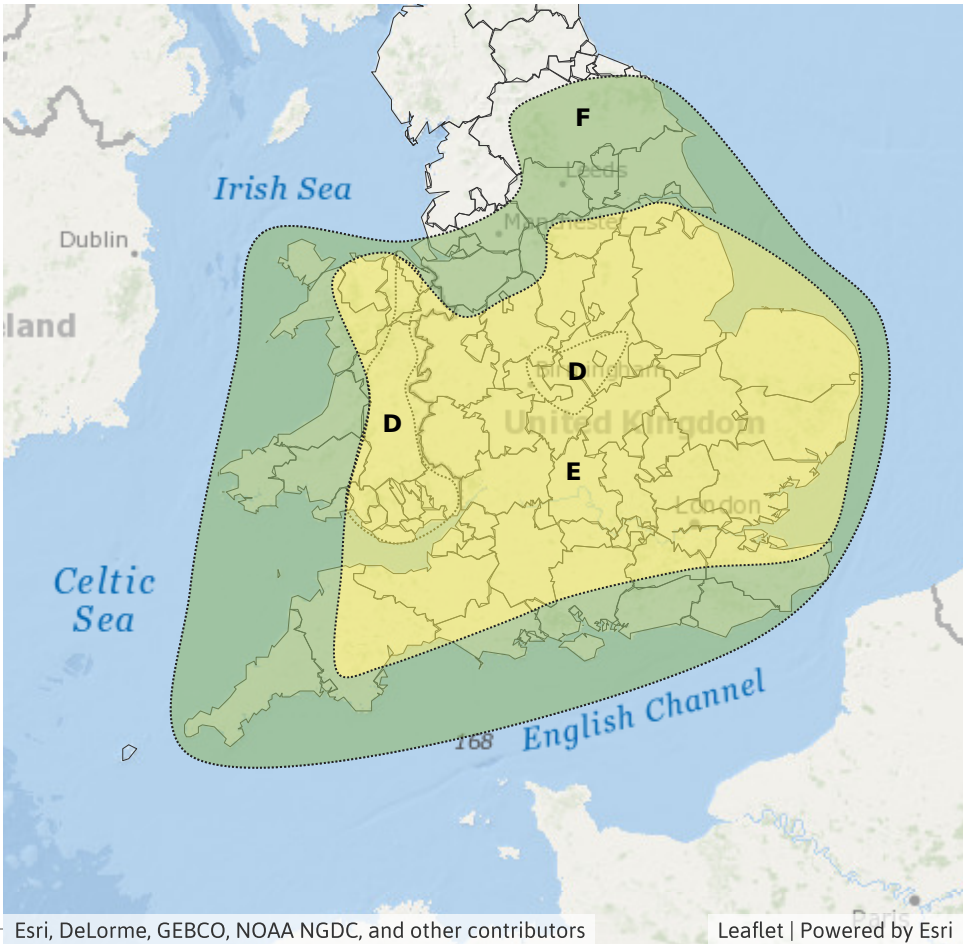

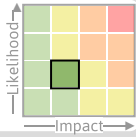

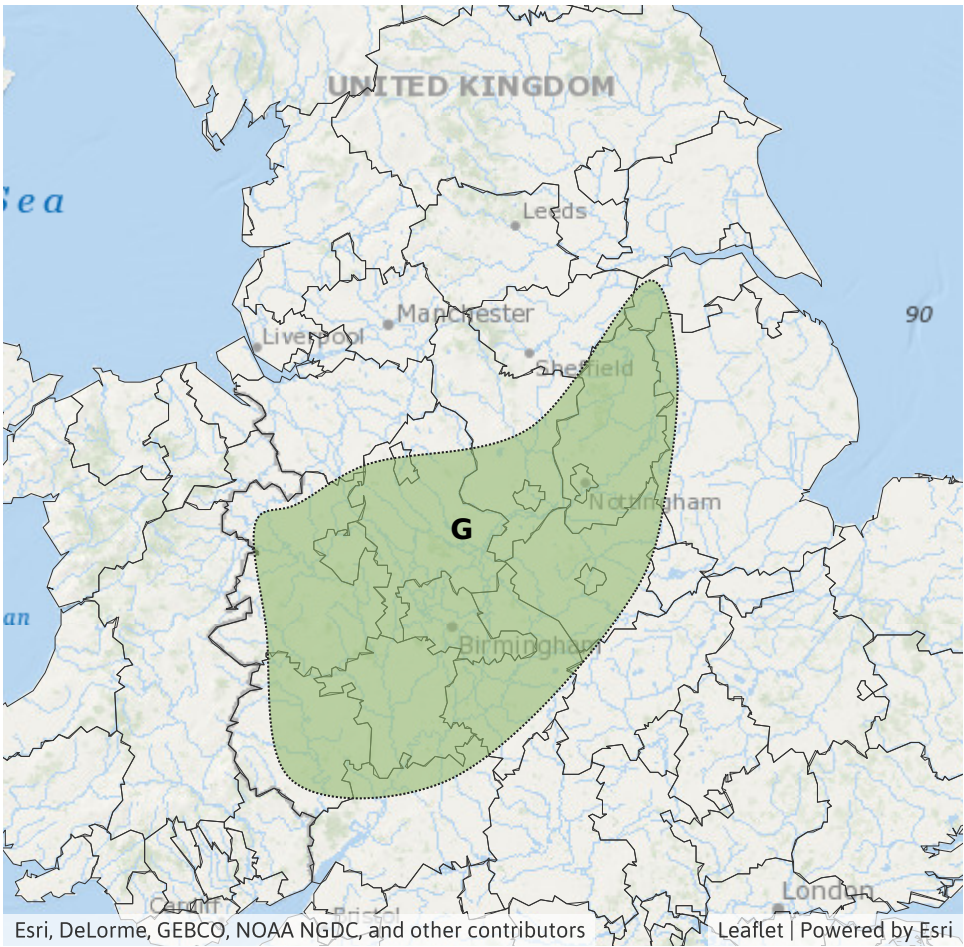
Likelihood **LOW**

## Assessment of flood risk



### Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW on Wednesday, Friday and Saturday.

Significant river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Wales today (Wednesday). Significant river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected on Friday and into Saturday across parts of England and Wales. Minor river flooding impacts are possible more broadly today and from Friday to Sunday. See Areas of Concern Maps for details.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England and Wales on Thursday.



### Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW on Wednesday and Friday.

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of Wales today (Wednesday) and for parts of England and Wales on Friday. Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable for the South West of England today. See Areas of Concern Maps for details.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of England and Wales on Thursday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



### Coastal/Tidal

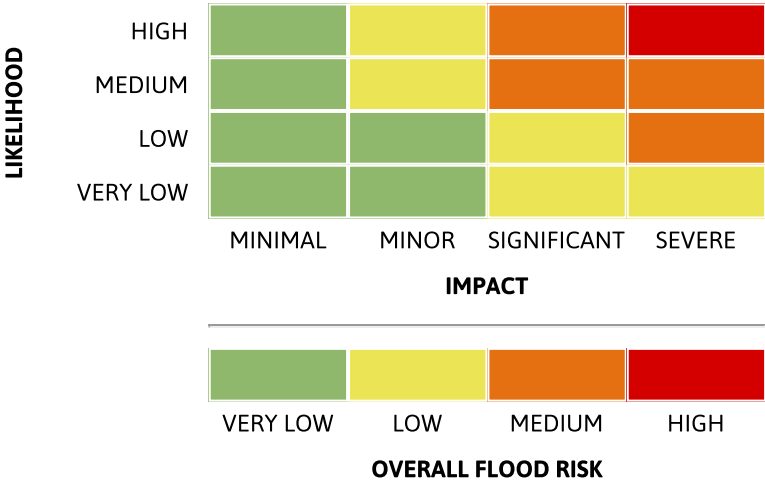
The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**  
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**  
Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**  
Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**  
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
