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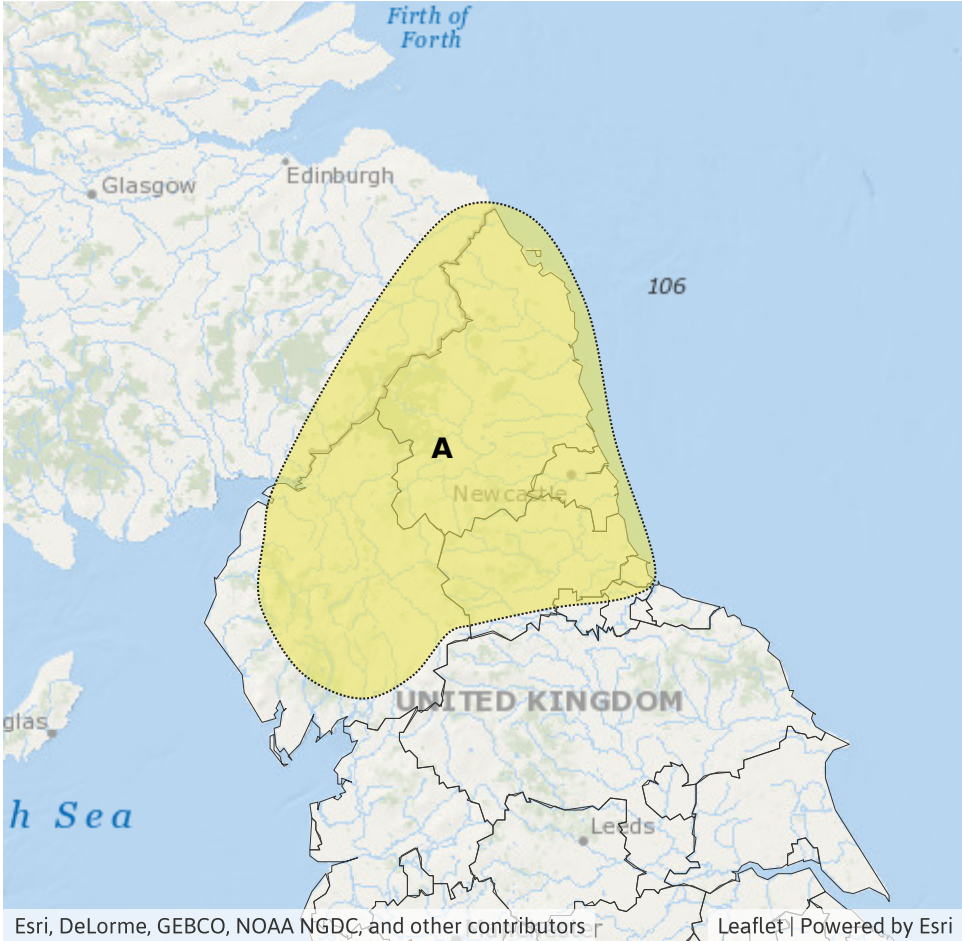

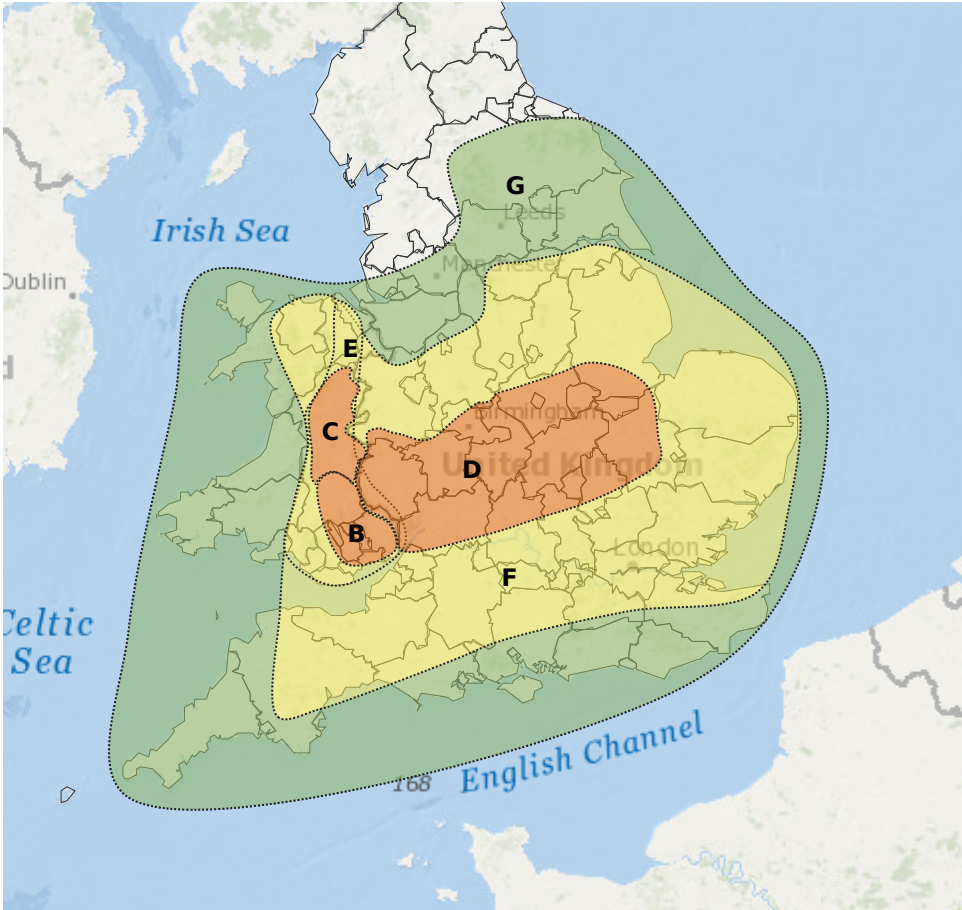

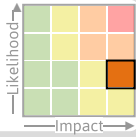

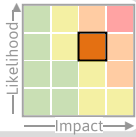

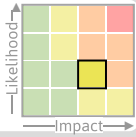

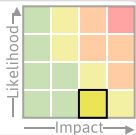

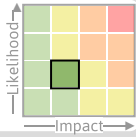

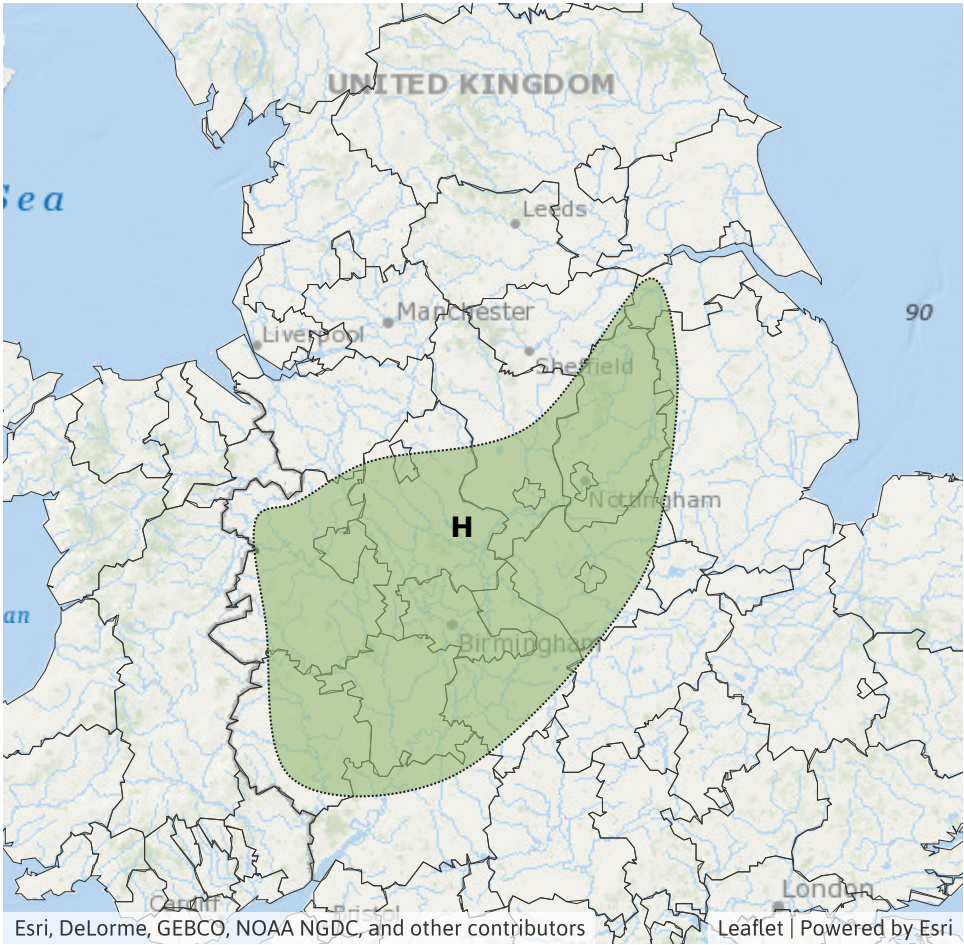

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is MEDIUM on Friday.

Severe surface water impacts are possible for parts of Wales on Friday. Significant surface water flooding impacts are probable for parts of Wales and possible more widely for parts of England and Wales on Friday. Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible more widely in England and Wales on Friday. Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of England and possible but not expected more widely in England and Wales today (Thursday).

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is MEDIUM on Friday and Saturday.

Severe river flooding impacts are possible on Friday and Saturday in parts of Wales. Significant river flooding impacts are probable across parts of Wales, and possible more widely for parts of England and Wales on Friday and into Saturday.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible more broadly from Friday to Sunday.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible in parts of England today (Thursday).

Coastal/Tidal

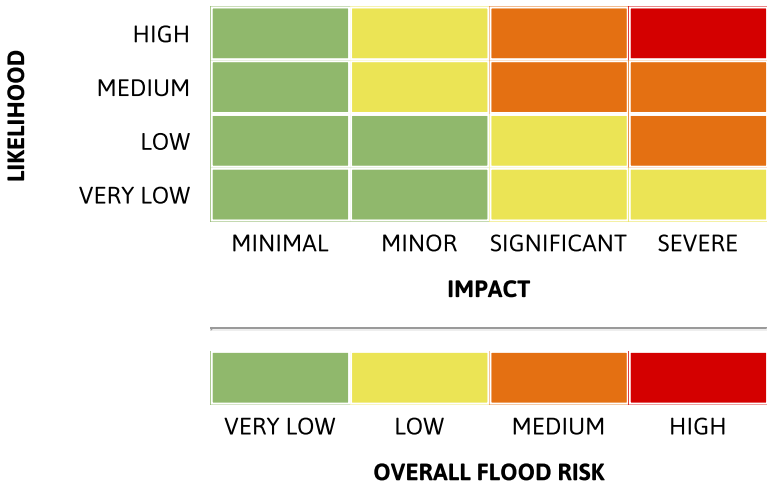
The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

- MINIMAL**
Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces
- MINOR**
Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SIGNIFICANT**
Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans
- SEVERE**
Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
