



Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 - Thursday 13 November 2025














Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 14 November














Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Saturday 15 November













Specific Areas of Concern Map 4 - Sunday 16 November 2025

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is MEDIUM on Friday.

Severe surface water impacts are possible for parts of Wales on Friday. Significant surface water flooding impacts are probable for parts of Wales and possible more widely for parts of England and Wales on Friday. Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible more widely in England and Wales on Friday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is MEDIUM on Friday and Saturday.

Severe river flooding impacts are possible on Friday and Saturday in parts of Wales.

Significant river flooding impacts are probable across parts of Wales, and possible more widely for parts of England and Wales on Friday and into Saturday.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible more broadly from Friday to Sunday.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible in parts of England today (Thursday).

Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
