


Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 - Wednesday 3 and Thursday 4 December 2025














Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 05 and Saturday 06 December 2025








Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW for the next five days.

Ongoing minor river flooding impacts are expected near Tenby from the river Ritec following recent rainfall and tide locking. Ongoing minor river flooding impacts are also possible today (Wednesday) and Thursday for some larger rivers in England. Minor river flooding impacts are also possible across parts of southwest England today and Thursday.

Minor river flooding impacts are again possible across Wales and parts of England on Friday and into Saturday, and possible but not expected more widely.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of the South West of England on today and into Thursday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across Wales and the South West of England on Friday and into Saturday, and possible but not expected more widely.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible along parts of the South Coast of England on Saturday. Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected more widely for parts of England and Wales from Friday to Sunday.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
