








### Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 5 to Sunday 7 December 2025
















## Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Monday 8 and Tuesday 9 December 2025

#### Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW for the next three days.

Significant river flooding is possible but not expected across parts of Powys today (Friday) and into Saturday.

Ongoing minor river flooding impacts are expected near Tenby from the River Ritec following recent rainfall and tide locking.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible across parts of England and Wales today (Friday) and Saturday, and again on Monday and Tuesday.

### Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW today (Friday) and on Saturday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable along parts the Carmarthenshire coast today (Friday) and on Saturday, and possible along parts of the South Coast of England from today (Friday) through to Sunday, and possible but not expected for wider parts of Wales today and Saturday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected on coasts of England and Wales again on Tuesday.



### Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of England and Wales on Friday and Saturday and again on Monday and Tuesday.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.






### 6-10 day forecast

### **Summary of potential impacts**

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
