

Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 - Saturday 6 December 2025
















Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Late Monday 8 December




Specific Areas of Concern Map 4 - Saturday 6 to Sunday 7 December 2025

Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW until Tuesday.

Ongoing minor river flooding impacts are expected today and tomorrow, near Tenby from the River Ritec, following recent rainfall and tide locking.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales on Sunday.

Significant river flooding impacts are possible but not expected from late Monday into Tuesday, with minor impacts possible more widely.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW on Monday and Tuesday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of England and Wales on Sunday.

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected from late on Monday and into Tuesday, with minor impacts possible more widely.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW today (Saturday) and on Sunday.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable along parts of the Carmarthenshire coast today, and parts of the south east coast of England today and tomorrow. Minor impacts are possible along wider parts of the South Coast of England today and tomorrow, and possible but not expected for wider parts of Wales today.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected on coasts of England and Wales again on Tuesday.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.






6-10 day forecast

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
